# Divine Rule; power comes from deity

New dynasty gains power, restores peace and order, and claims to have Mandate of Heaven.


Dynasty is overthrown through rebellion and bloodshed; new dynasty emerges. Strong dynasty establishes peace and prosperity; it is considered to have Mandate of Heaven.

#### **Dynastic Cycle in China**

Old dynasty is seen as having lost Mandate of Heaven; rebellion is justified. In time, dynasty declines and becomes corrupt; taxes are raised; power grows weaker.

Disasters such as floods, famines, peasant revolts, and invasions occur.





2. "Our constitution is called a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ because power is in the hands not of a minority but of the whole people. When it is a question of settling private disputes, everyone is equal before the law; when it is a question of putting one person before another in positions of public responsibility, what counts is not membership in a particular class, but the actual ability which the man possesses. No one, so long as he has it in him to be of service to the state, is kept in political obscurity because of poverty."






