





- Spain became jealous and commissioned Christopher Columbus










### Spain

 First Europeans to have colonies in the Americas

- Conquistadors or Spanish conquers defeated the Aztec and Incas
  - Used advanced weapons and disease to win
- To keep power Spanish colonists used Encomienda and forced Spanish culture (language and religion) on Native Americans
- Encomienda is the Spanish labor system.
  - Natives provide labor and receive protection and Catholicism

# Body Paragraph



Martin Luther beat to his own drum.


### **Type**




