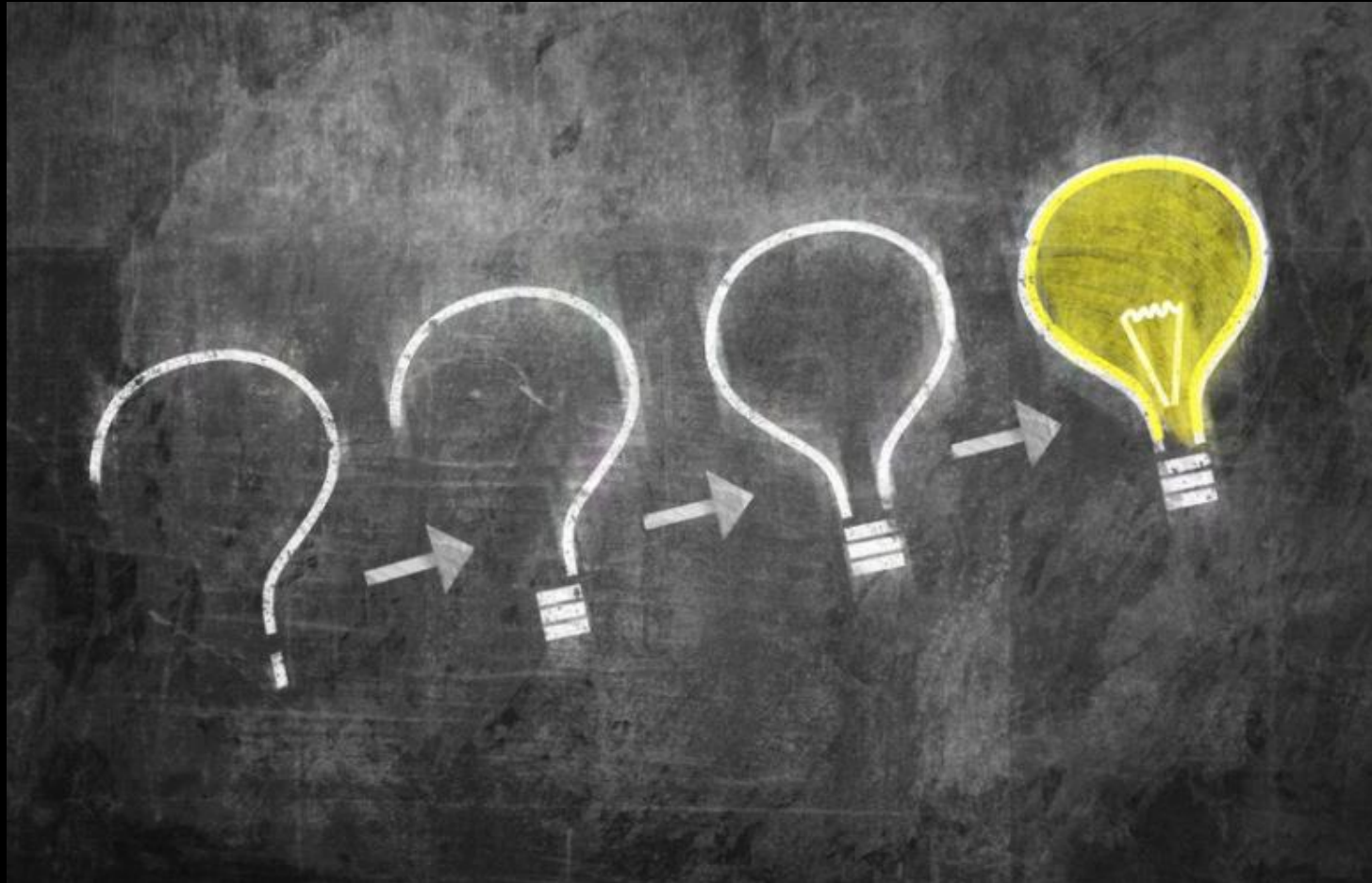

What happened during WWI?

June 28, 1914 - Archduke Franz Ferdinand is assassinated. (Schlieffen Plan)

July 28, 1914 - Austria-Hungary declares war on Serbia.

August 1-4, 1914 - Germany declares war on Russia and France and invades Belgium

August 4, 1914 - Britain declares war on Germany.

September 5 to 12, 1914 - The First Battle of the Marne. Trench warfare begins.

February 4, 1915 - The Germans use submarines against Allied ships.

May 7, 1915 - A German submarine sinks The Lusitania.

July 1, 1916 - The Battle of the Somme begins. Over 1 million soldiers will be wounded or killed.

January 19, 1917 - The British intercept the Zimmerman Telegram.

April 6, 1917 - The United States enters the war, declaring war on Germany.

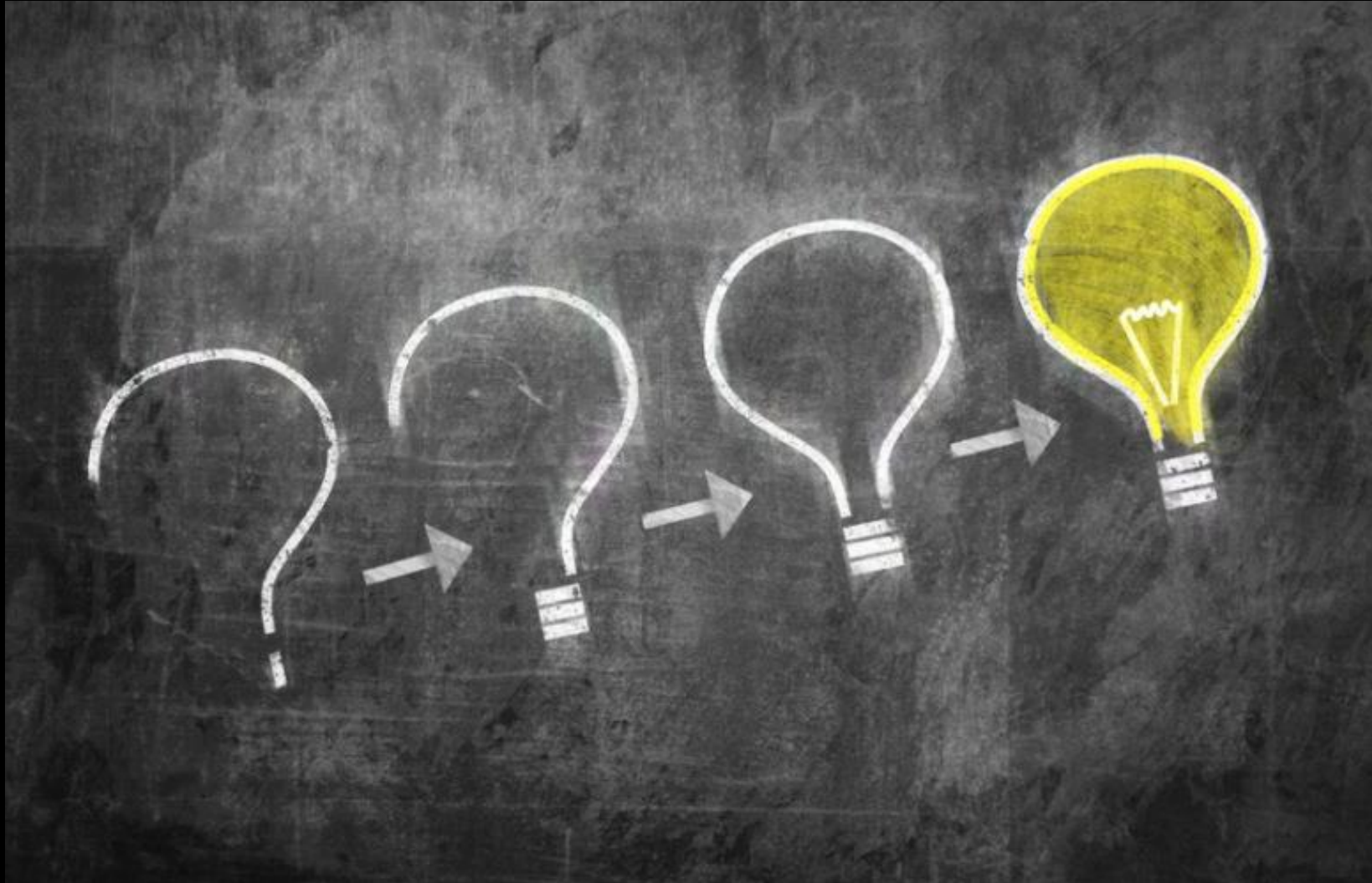

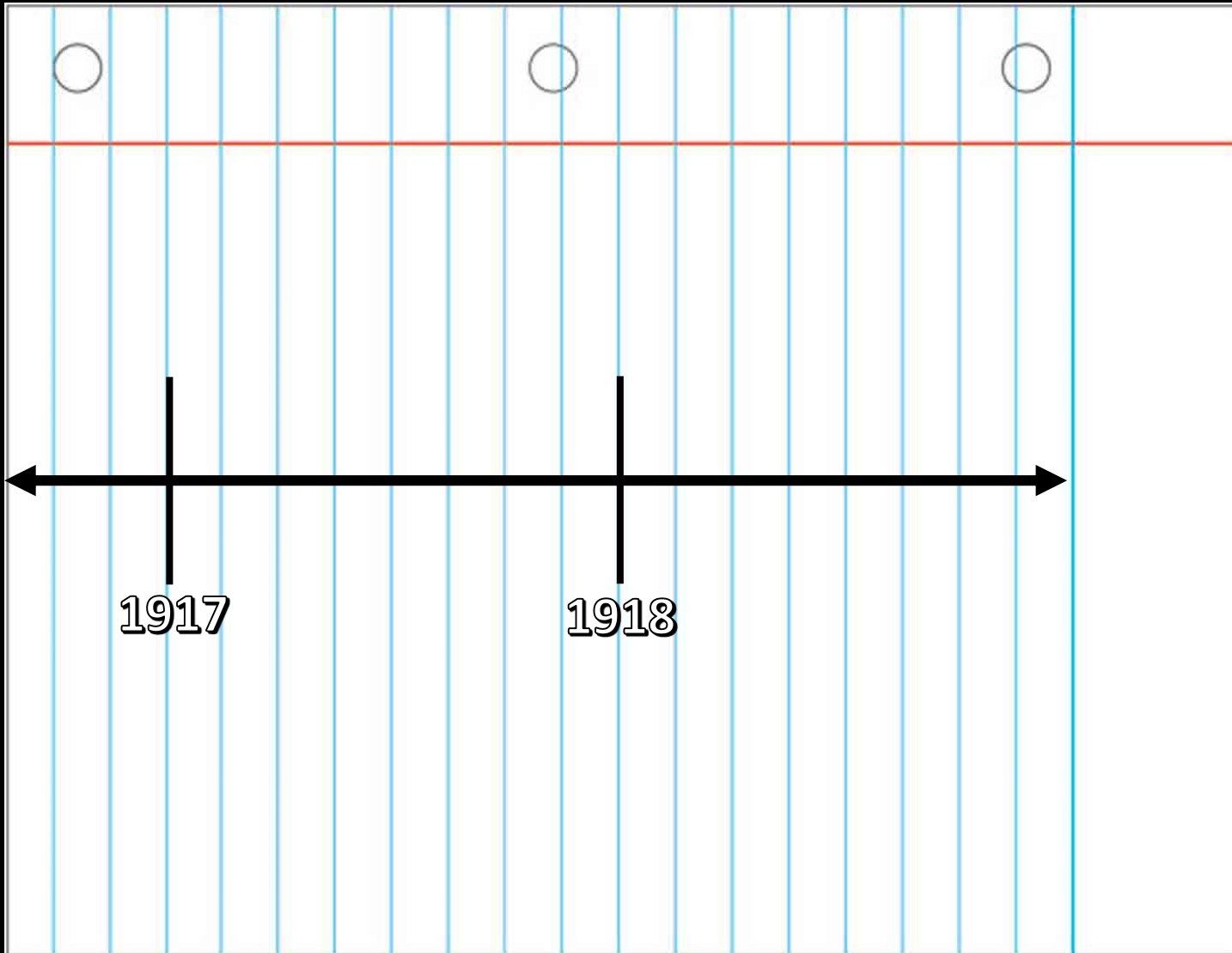

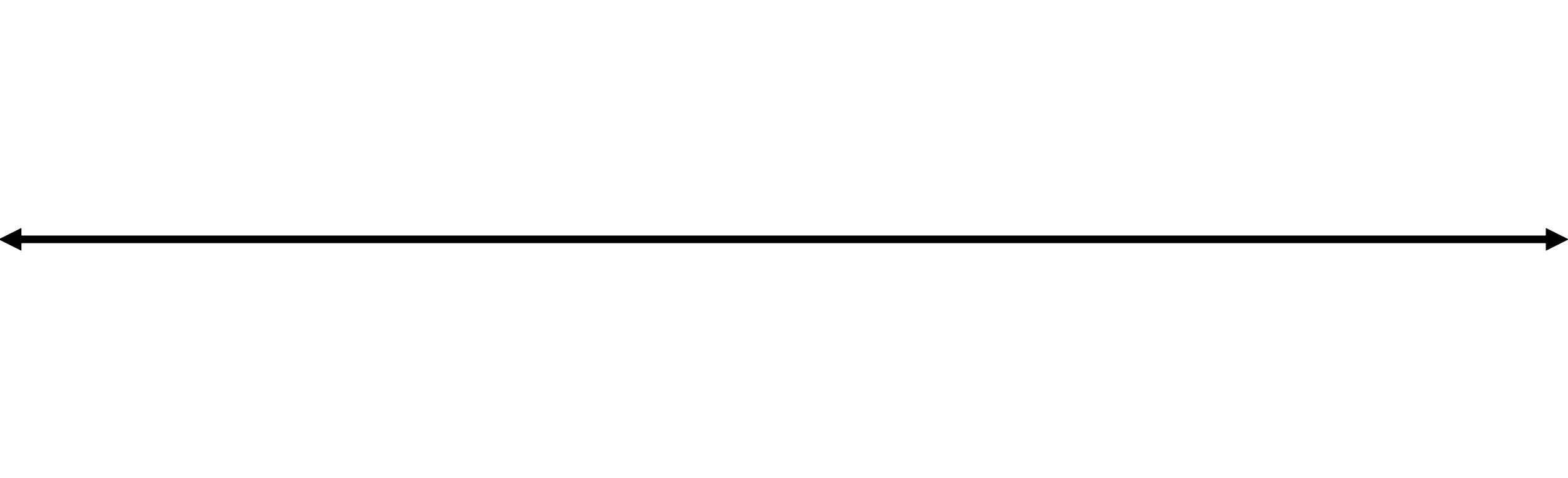

WWI: Eastern Front End

March of 1917

- Czar or King of Russia abdicates or gives up the throne
El zar o el rey de Rusia abdica o renuncia al trono
- The Russian people begin to fight various civil wars
El pueblo ruso comienza a librar diversas guerras civiles.



WWI: Eastern Front End

November of 1917

- Communist leader Vladimir Lenin seizes power and offers Germany a truce or peace
El líder comunista Vladimir Lenin toma el poder y ofrece a Alemania una tregua o paz



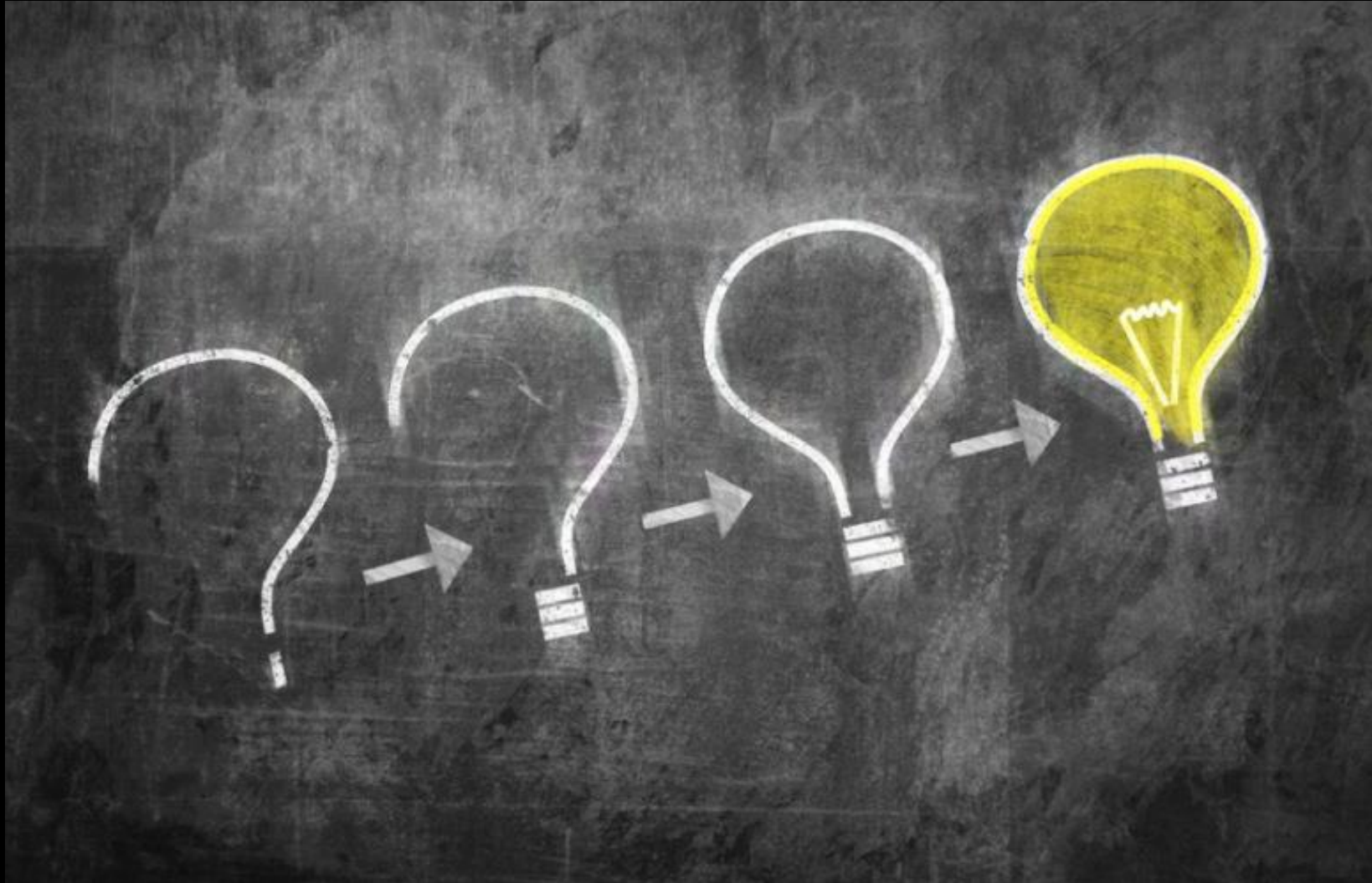
March of 1918

WWI: Eastern
Front End

- Germany and Russia sign the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk
Alemania y Rusia firman el Tratado de Brest-Litovsk
 - Peace negotiation where Russia and Germany would stop fighting but Russia had to give up territory that would later form new nations.
Negociaciones de paz donde Rusia y Alemania dejarían de luchar, pero Rusia tuvo que abandonar un territorio que luego formaría nuevas naciones.

One Front War

Germany crushes the Allies for a few months.

Alemania aplasta a los aliados durante unos meses.



WWI: Western Front End

July 1918

- Second Battle of Marne

Segunda batalla de Marne

- Allies with fresh U.S. troops fight the Germans back to Germany

Los aliados con nuevas tropas estadounidenses combaten a los alemanes en Alemania

- Begin the Central Powers collapse / Comienza el colapso de los poderes centrales



WWI: Western Front End

November 9, 1918

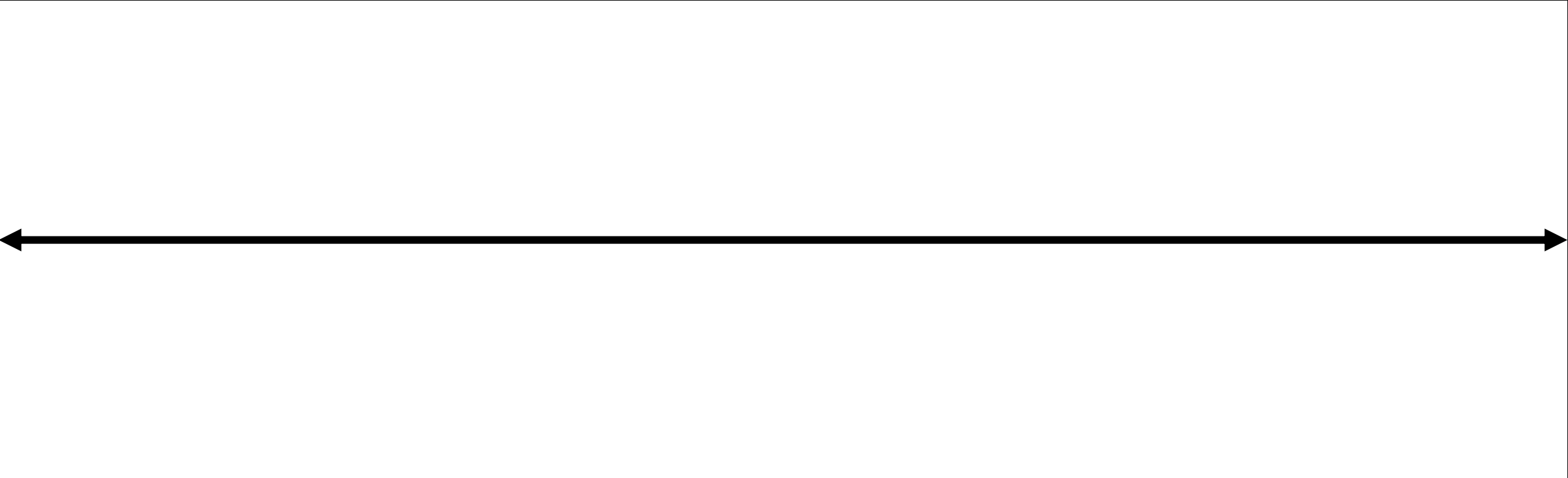
- Kaiser or King/Leader Wilhelm abdicates from Germany leadership
Kaiser o el Rey / Líder Wilhelm abdica del liderazgo de Alemania



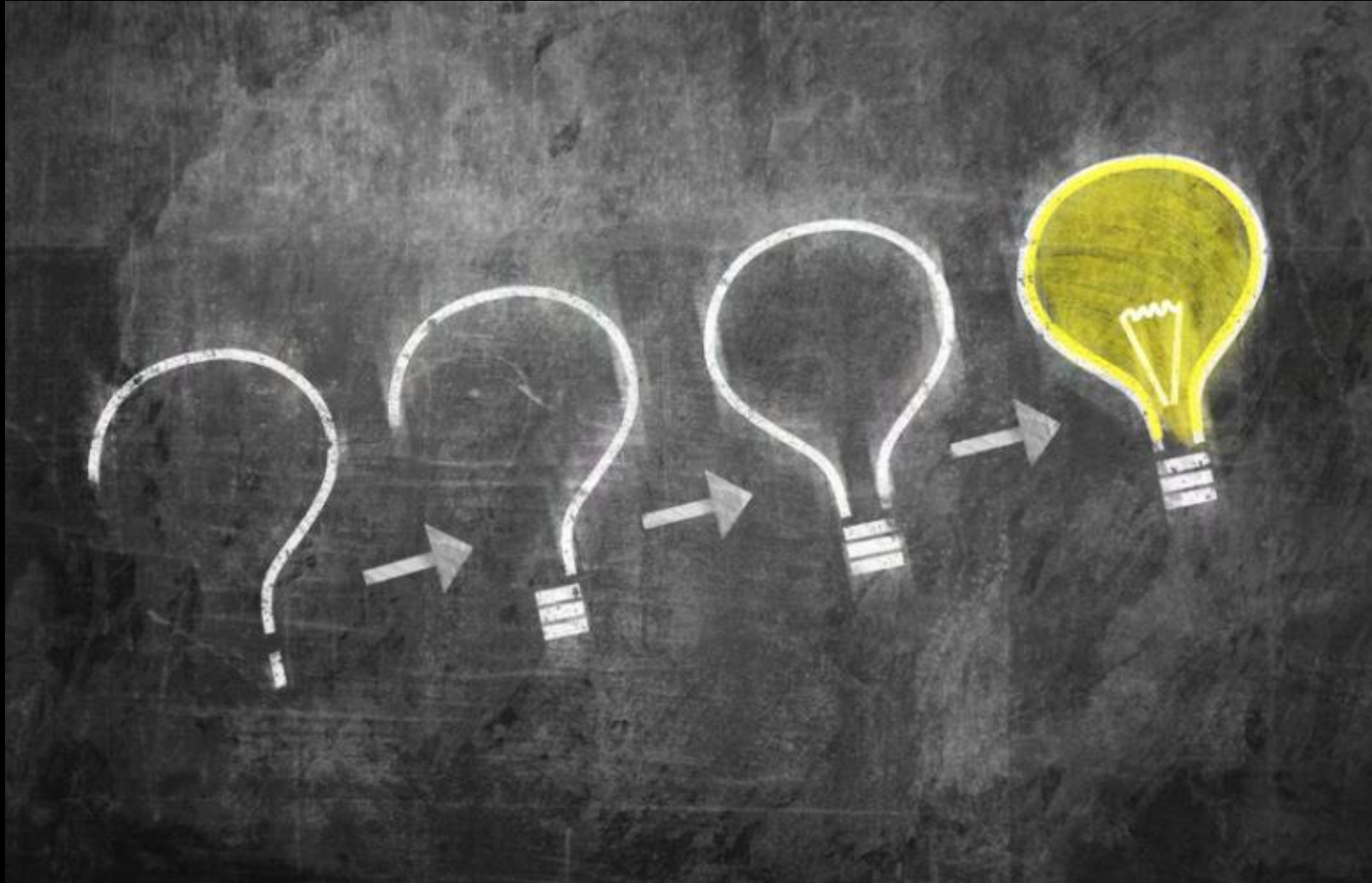
WWI: Western Front End

November 11, 1918

- Germany and France signed a armistice or agreement to stop fighting at 11am
Alemania y Francia firmaron un armisticio o acuerdo para dejar de luchar a las 11 am
- 11/11 is Armistice Day or Veterans Day. Día del Armisticio o Día de los Veteranos.

- Total cost was \$338 billion dollars
- Enormous amount of suffering

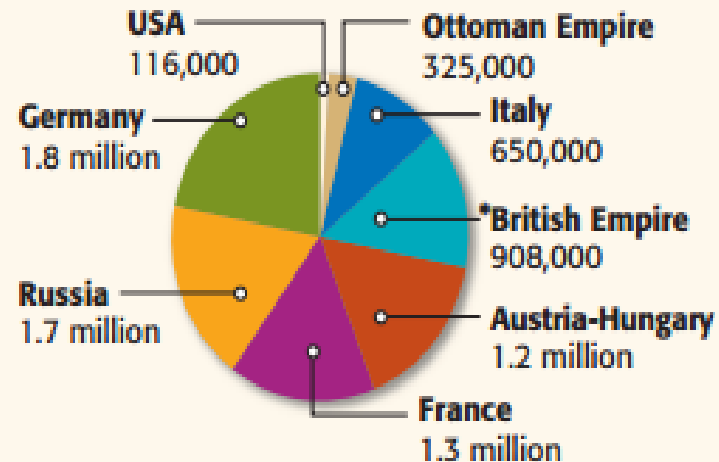
World War I Statistics

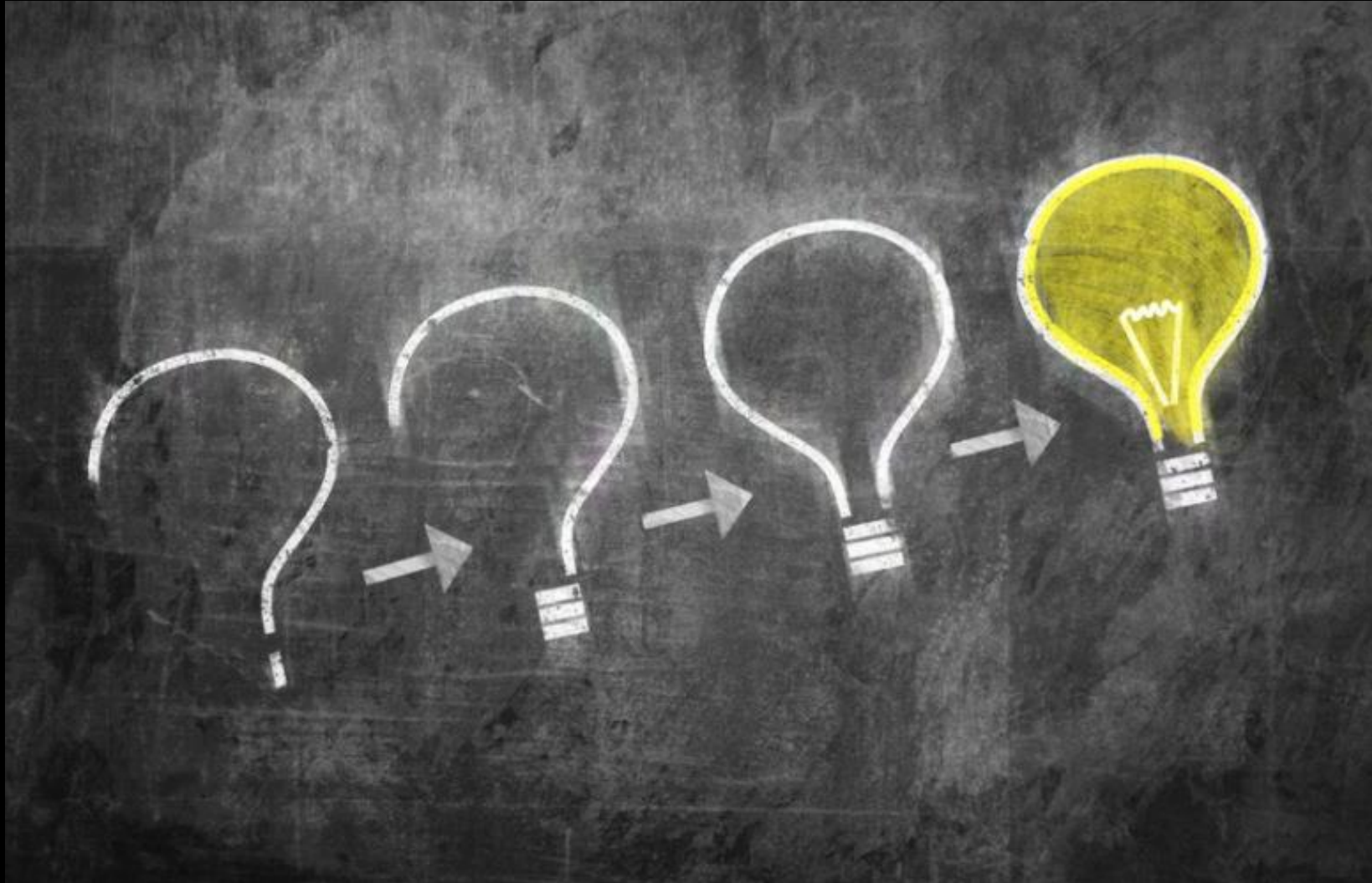

Treaty of Versailles: June 28, 1919

The Treaty of Versailles: Major Provisions

League of Nations

- International peace organization; enemy and neutral nations initially excluded
- Germany and Russia excluded

Territorial Losses

- Germany returns Alsace-Lorraine to France; French border extended to west bank of Rhine River
- Germany surrenders all of its overseas colonies in Africa and the Pacific

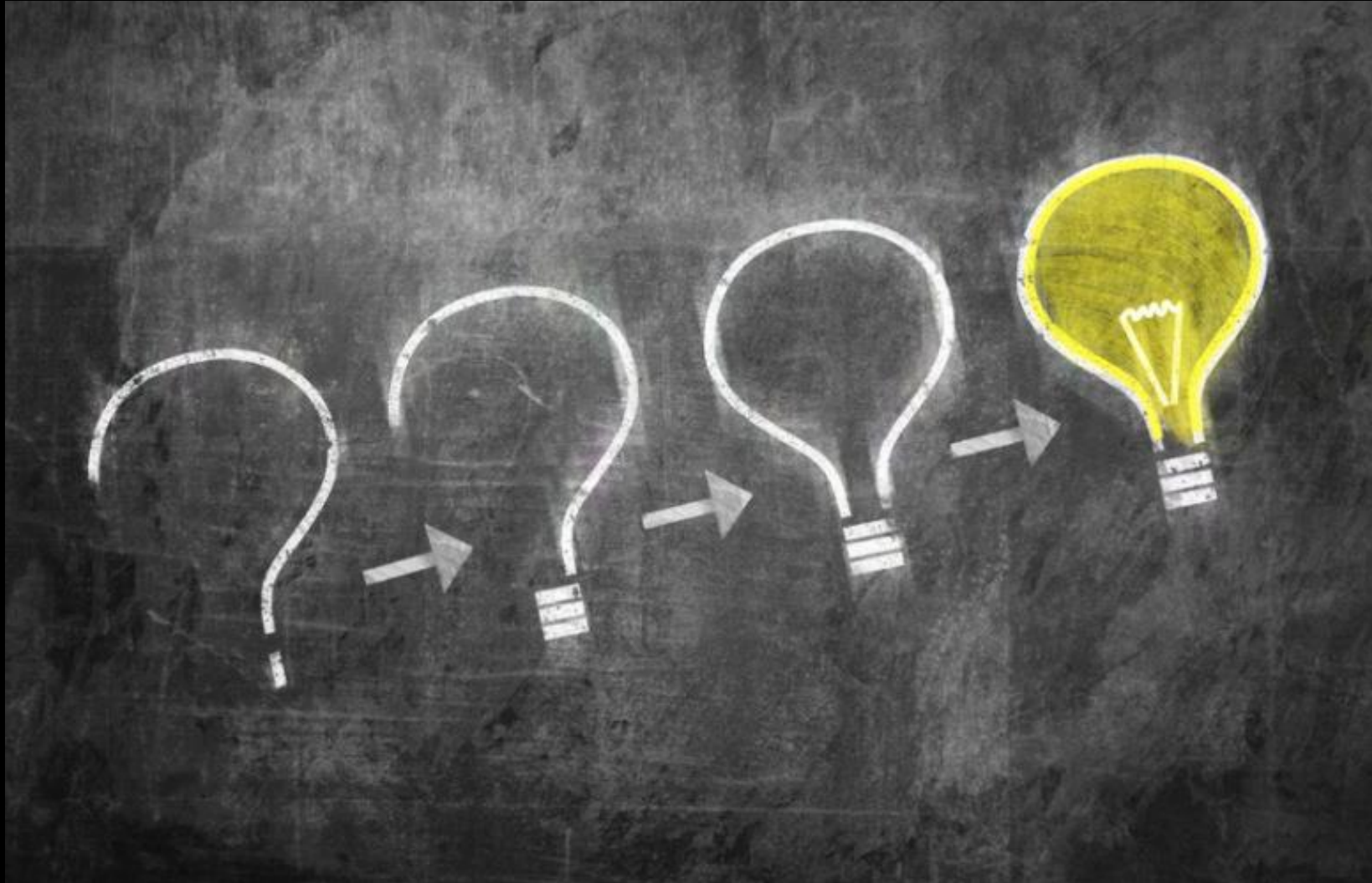
Military Restrictions

- Limits set on the size of the German army
- Germany prohibited from importing or manufacturing weapons or war material
- Germany forbidden to build or buy submarines or have an air force

War Guilt

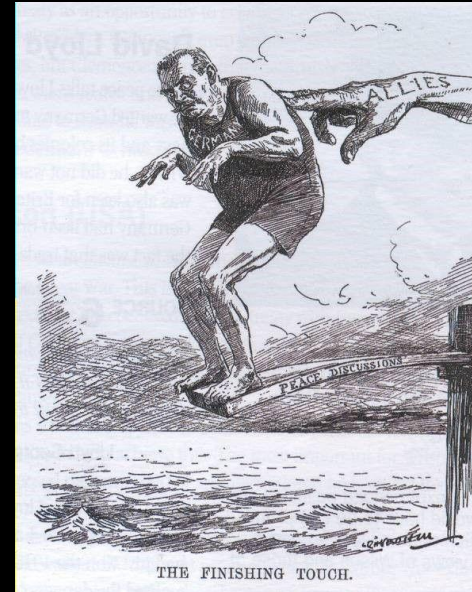
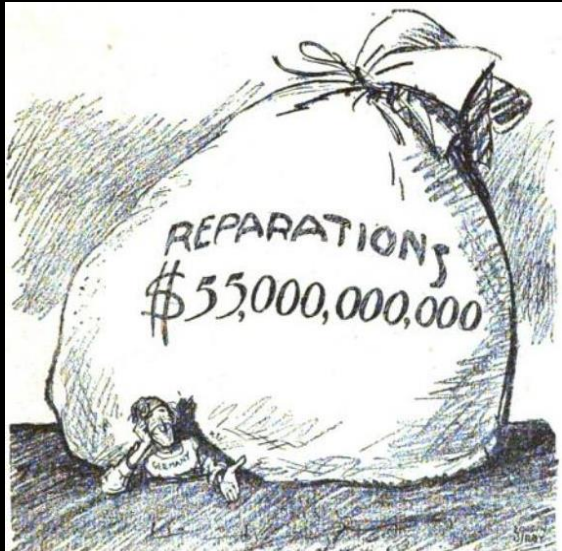
- Sole responsibility for the war placed on Germany's shoulders
- Germany forced to pay the Allies \$33 billion in reparations over 30 years

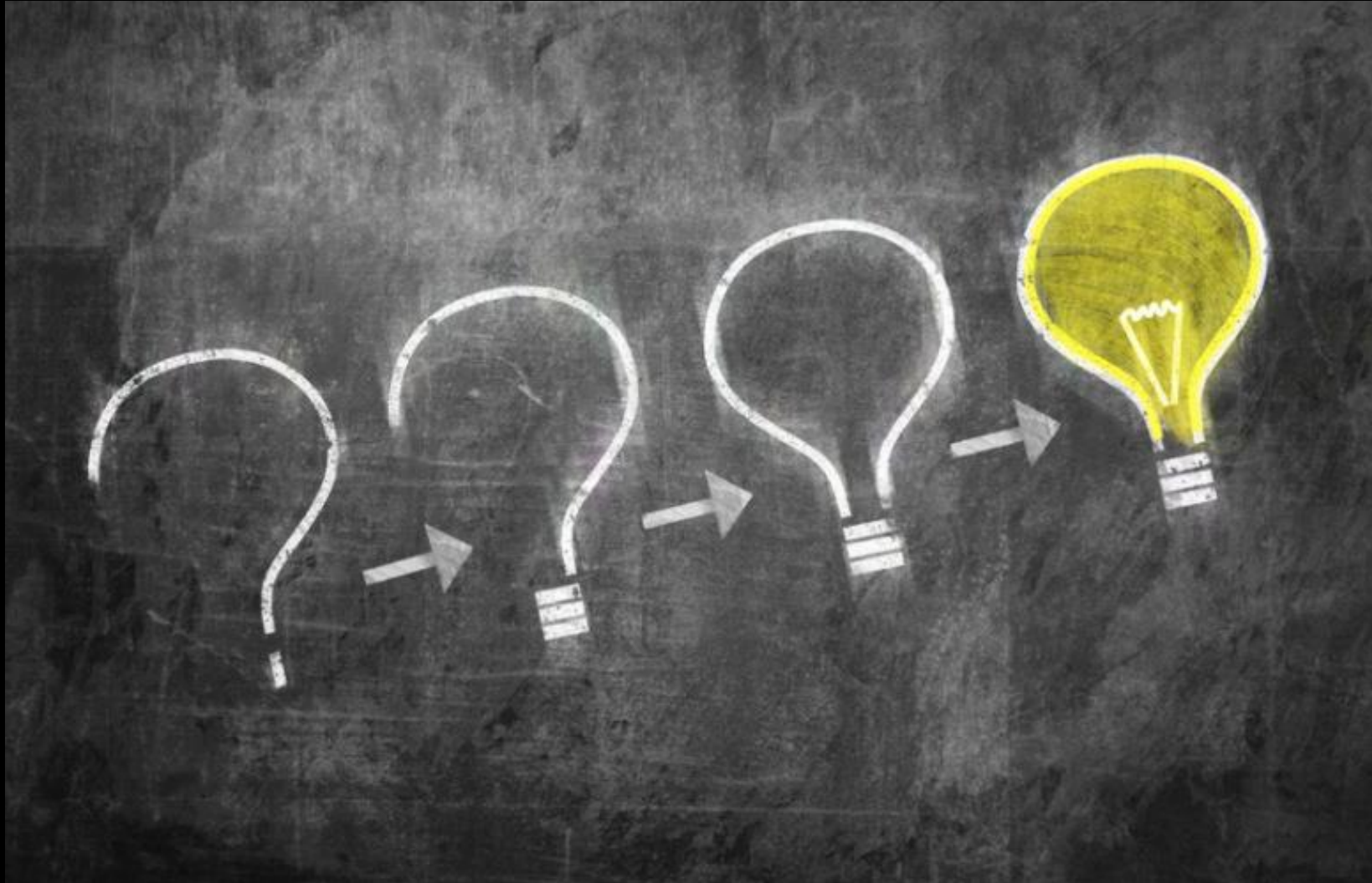

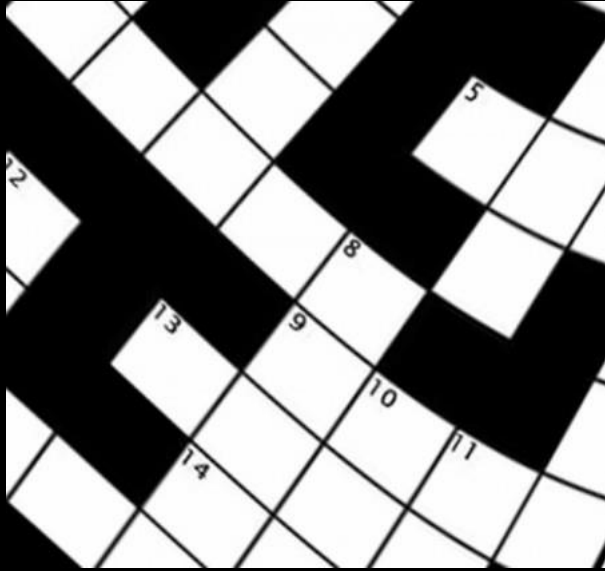

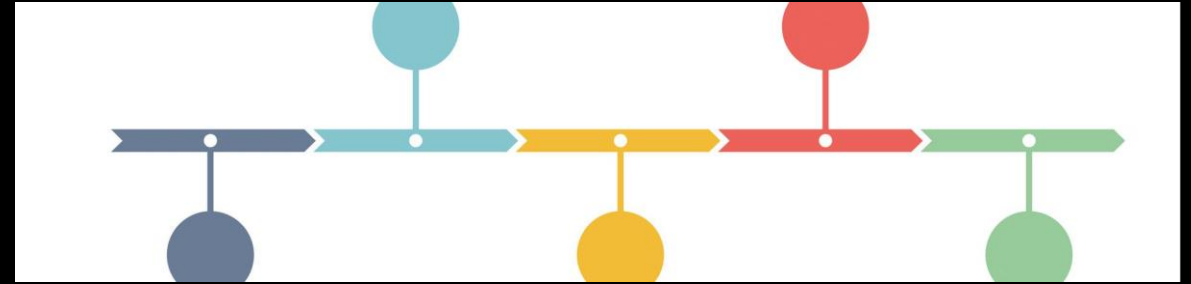
