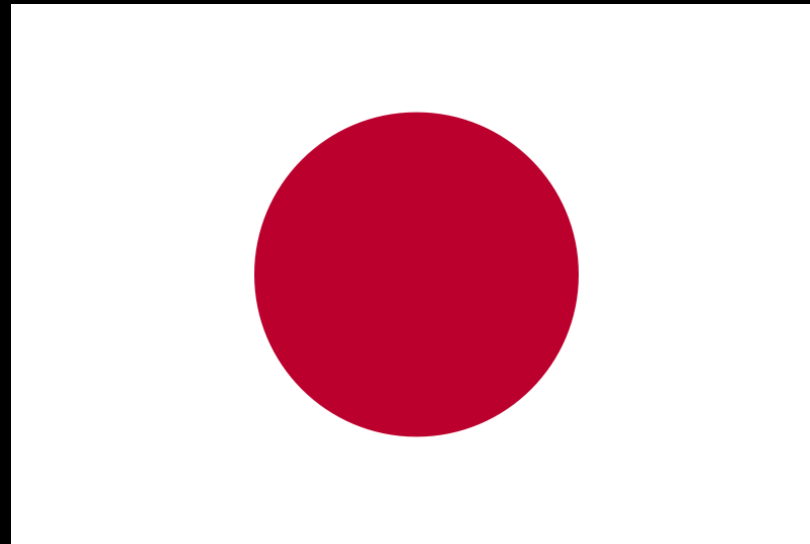

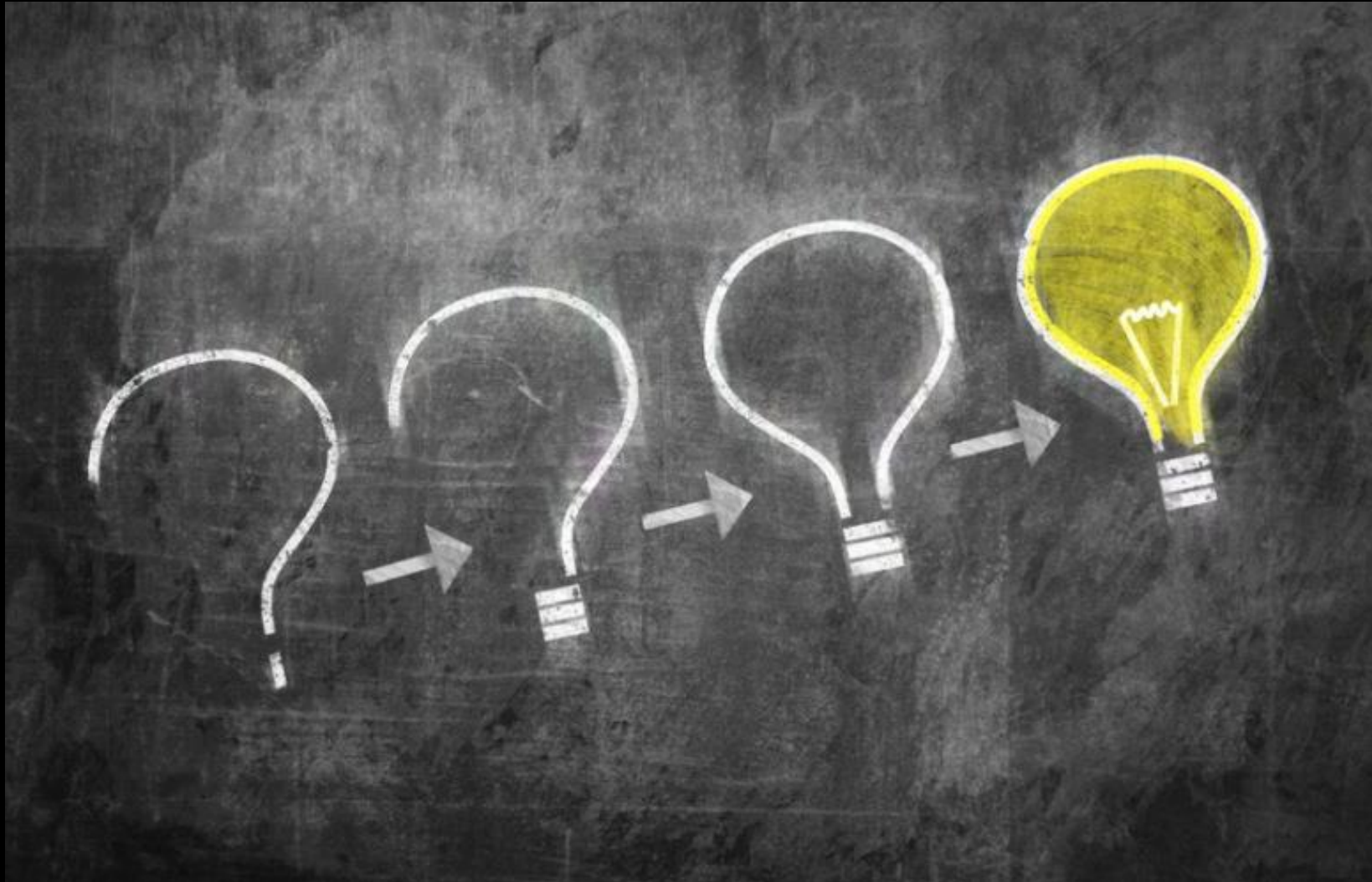

# Types of Nationalism / Tipos de nacionalismo

## Unification / Unificación

Merger of politically divided but culturally similar lands

Fusión de tierras políticamente divididas pero culturalmente similares.

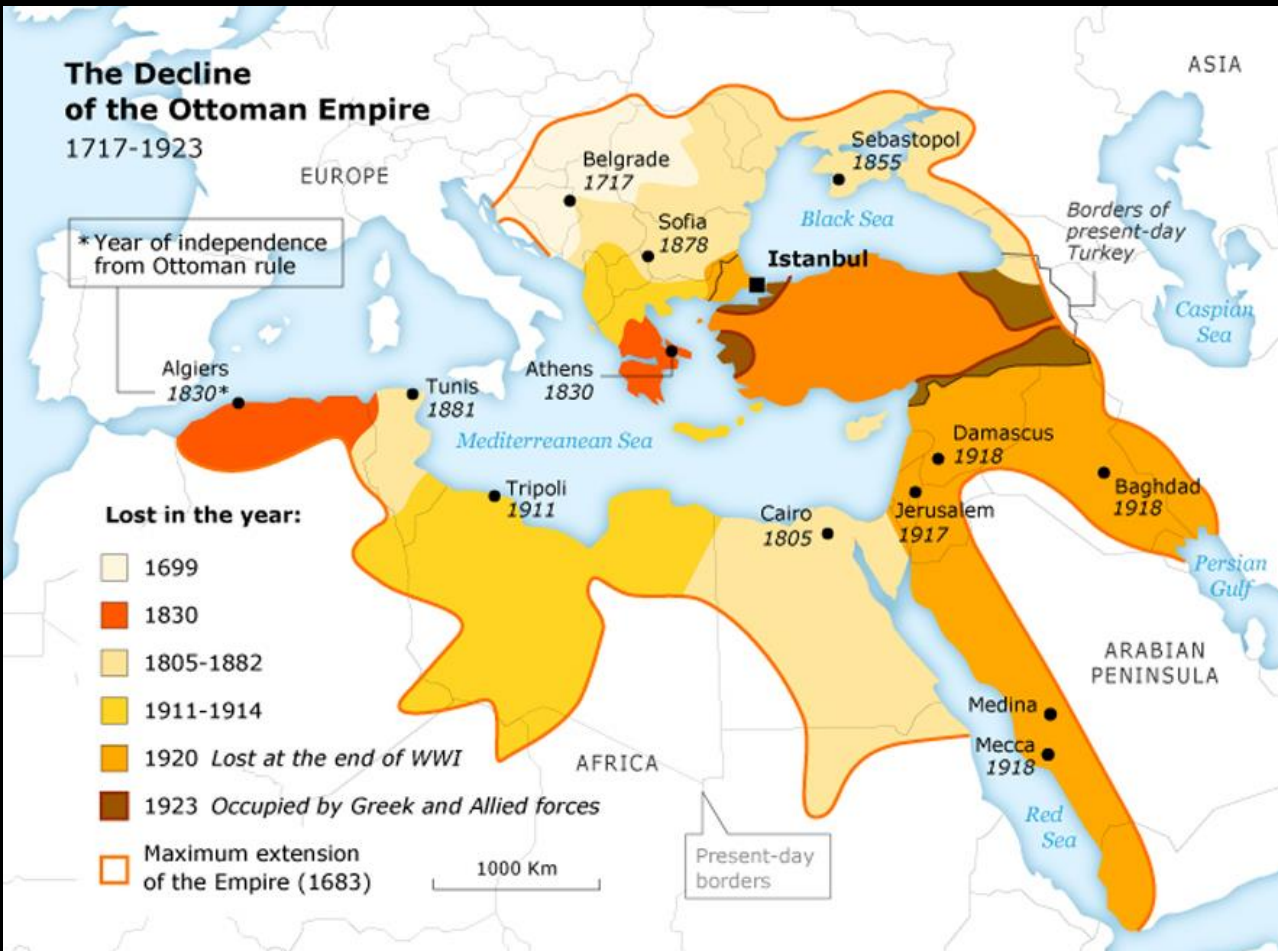


# Types of Nationalism / Tipos de nacionalismo

## Separation / Separación

Culturally distinct groups resist being added to the state and tries to break away

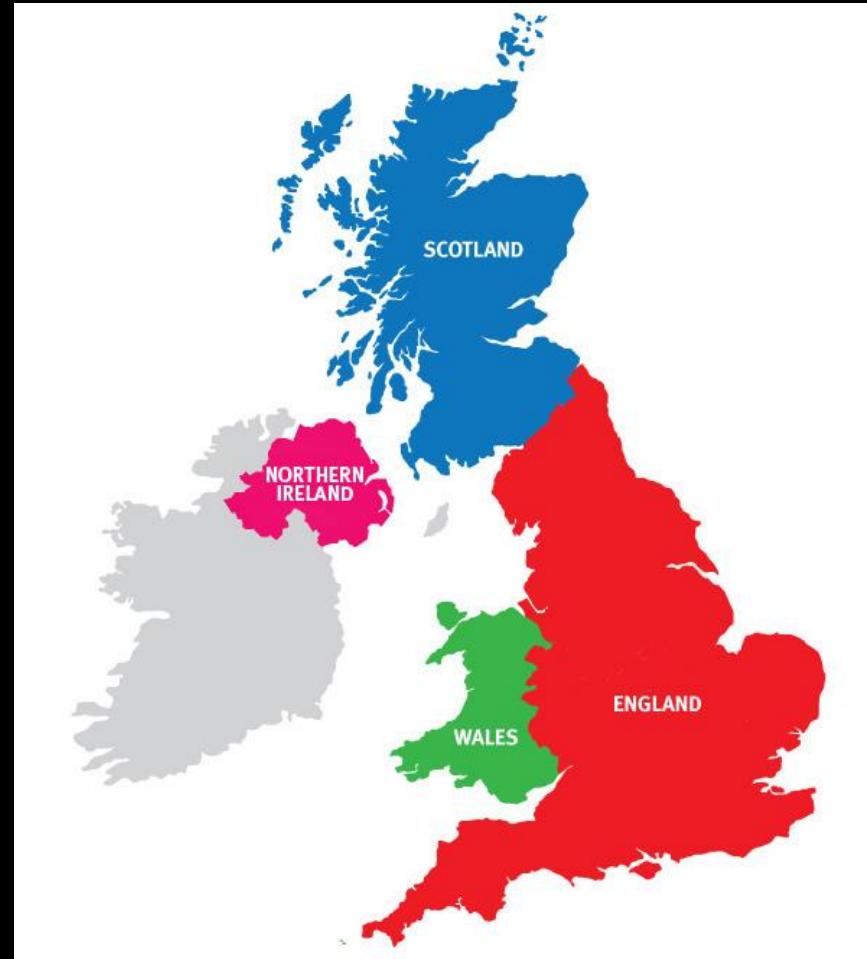
Grupos culturalmente distintos se resisten a ser agregados al estado e intentan separarse



# Types of Nationalism / Tipos de nacionalismo

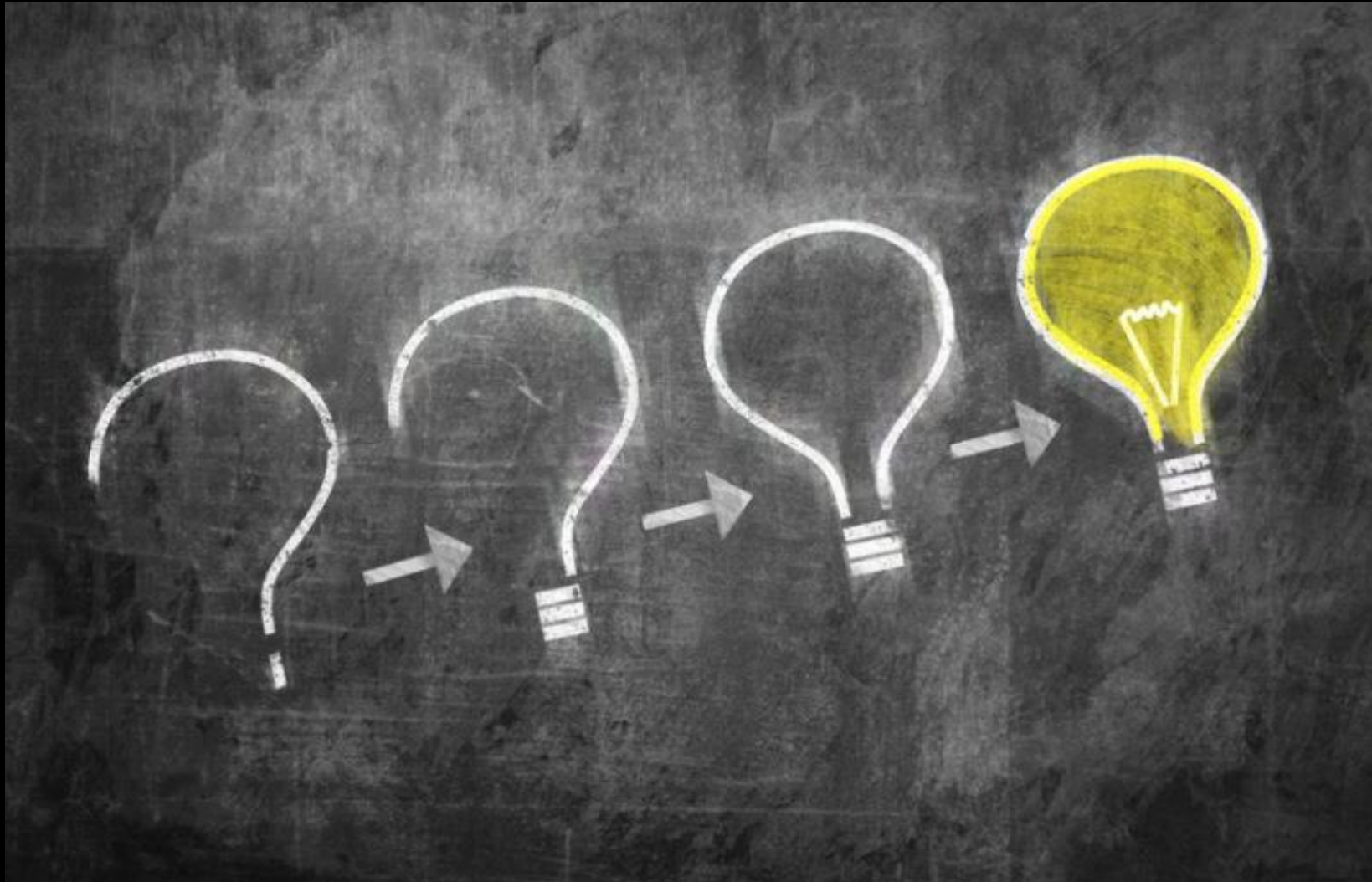
## State-building / Contrucción del Estado

Culturally distinct groups form a new state by accepting a single culture
