Born in 100 BCE

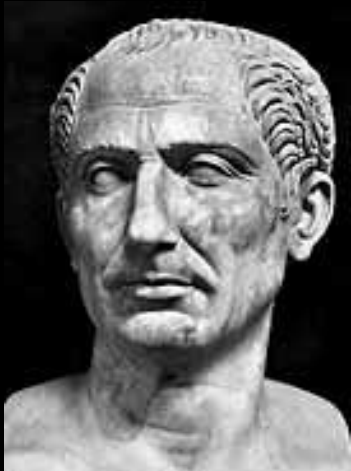
Joins Triumvirate in 60 BCE

Assassinated On March 15, 44 BCE



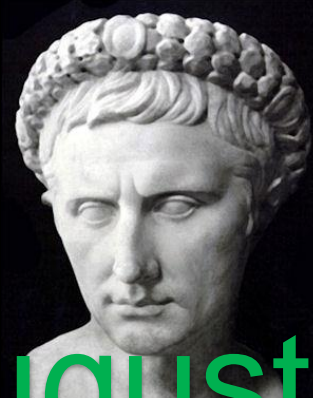
Civil War leads to New Government

After Cesar's death there is another civil war. Second Triumvirate takes power.

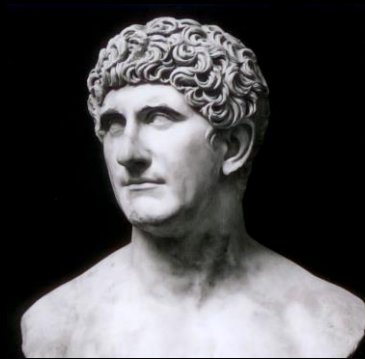

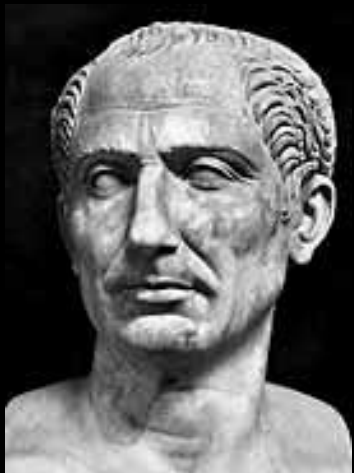

- First emperor and took the title Augustus or exalted one.

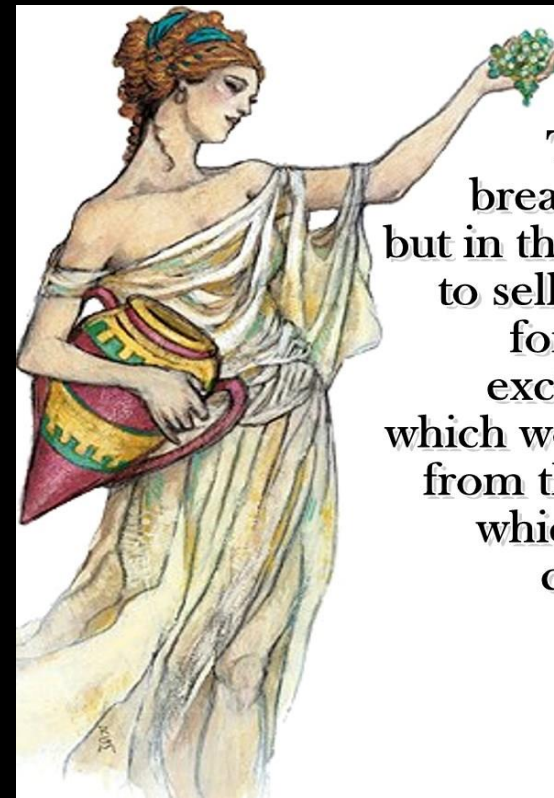

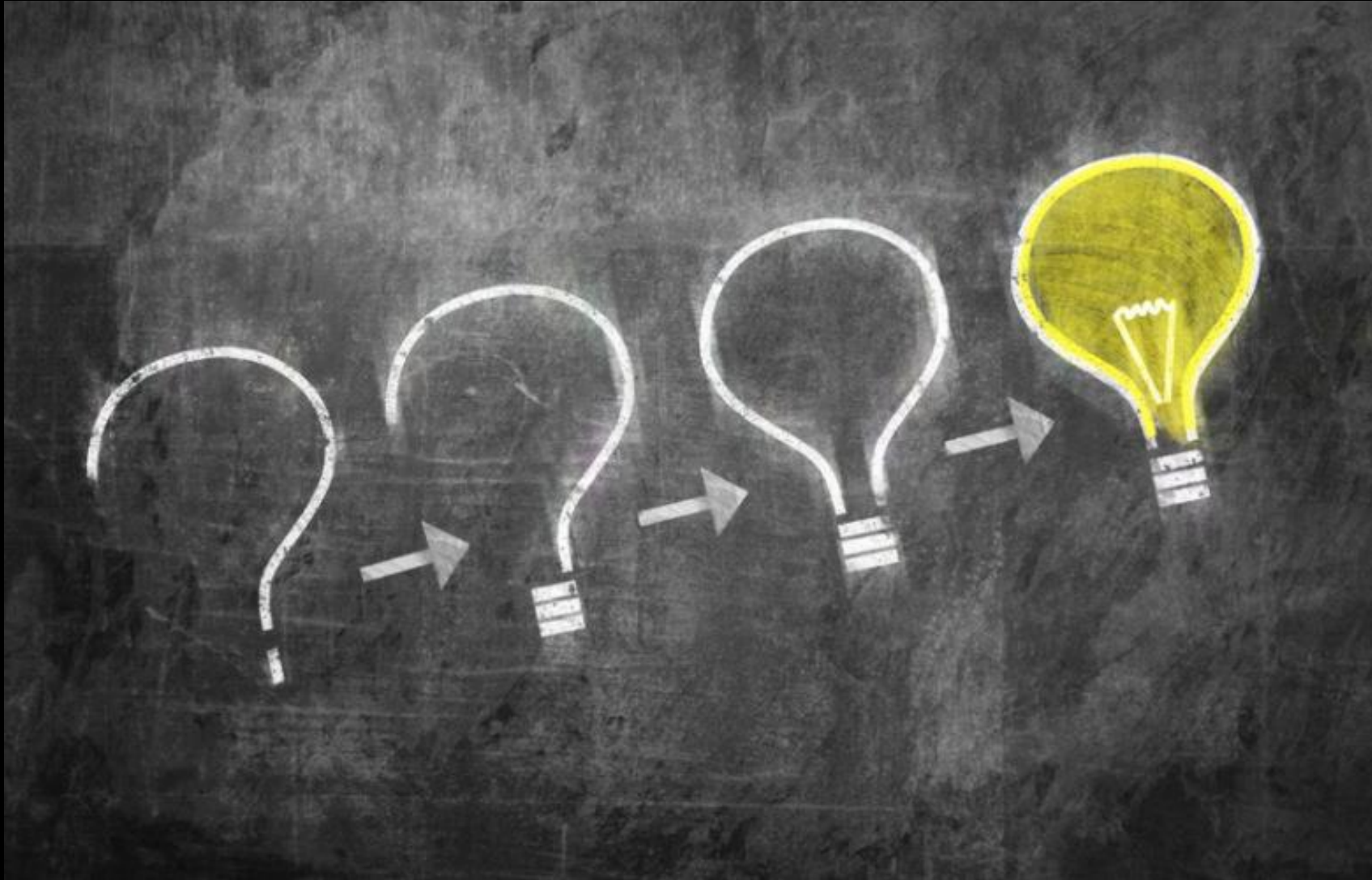

Background Essay: Caption Method

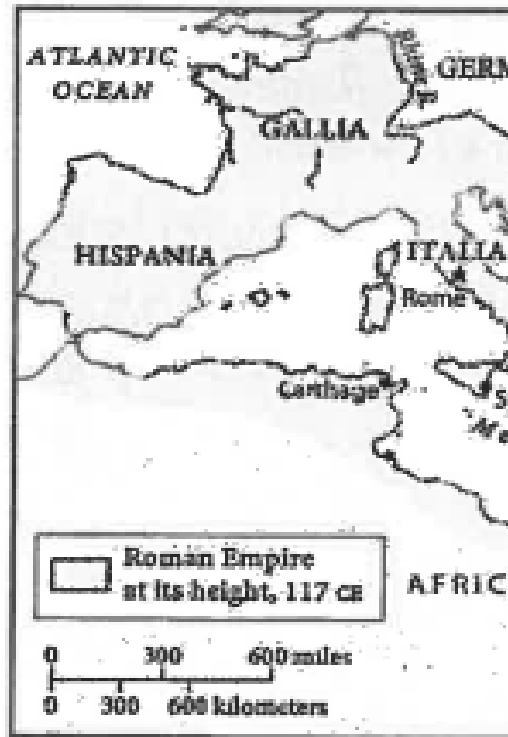

Background Essay: Caption Method

As with so many empires, Rome's rise to power came with the thrust of a spear and the slash of a sword. The enormous Roman army conquered territory from modern-day Scotland to Spain, gained control of the whole Mediterranean Sea, and established colonies in North Africa, Egypt, the Middle East and Asia Minor. By the year 44 BCE, when Julius Caesar became Rome's virtual emperor, there were no major rivals left to defeat.

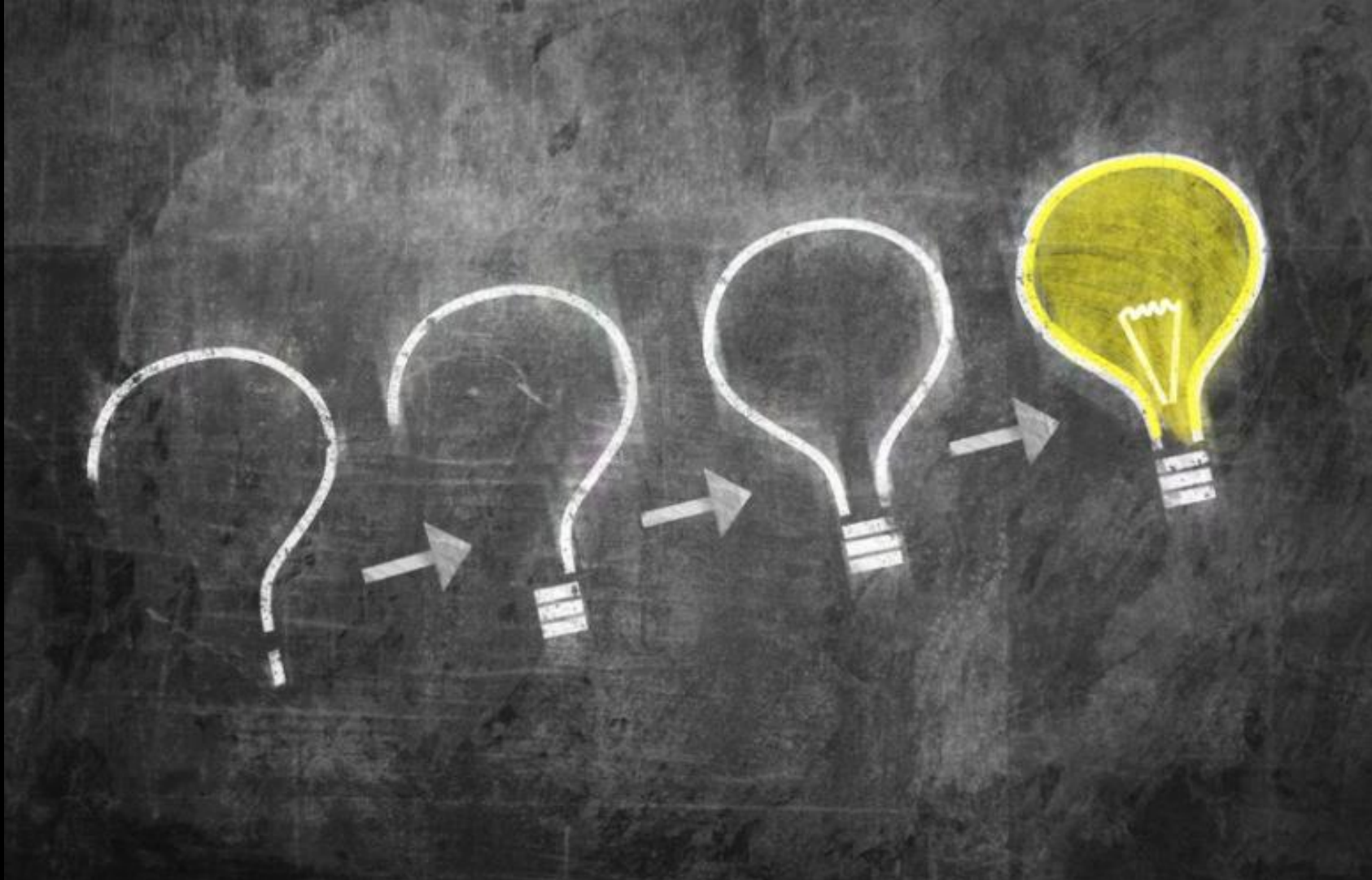

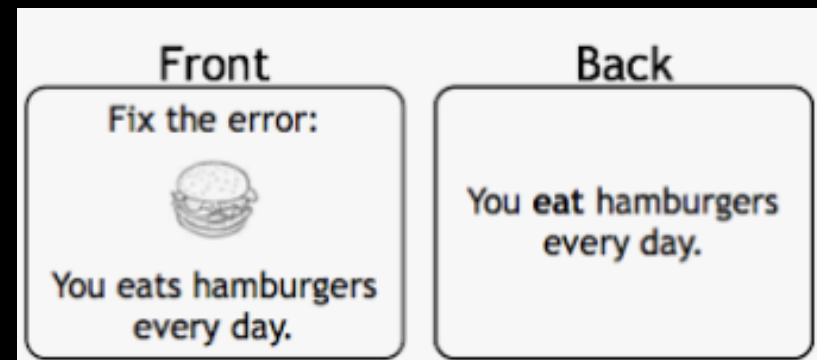
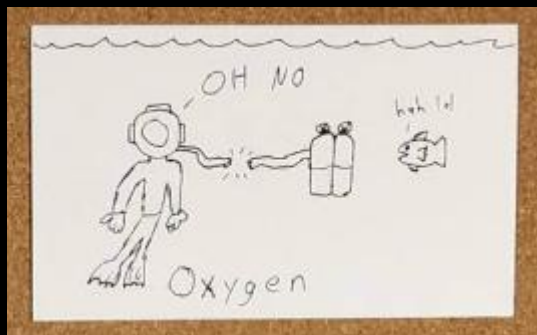

Flashcards

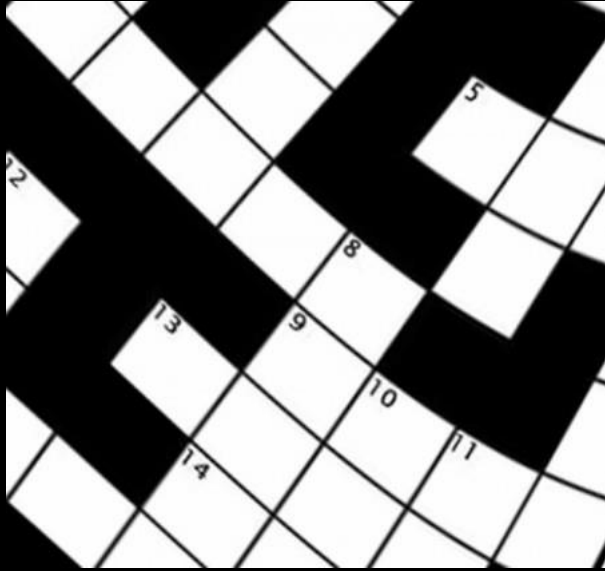
Effective flashcards have combine pictures and words to describe each vocabulary word while writing the definition on the back.

4. Answer yourself verbally and use the cards both ways.

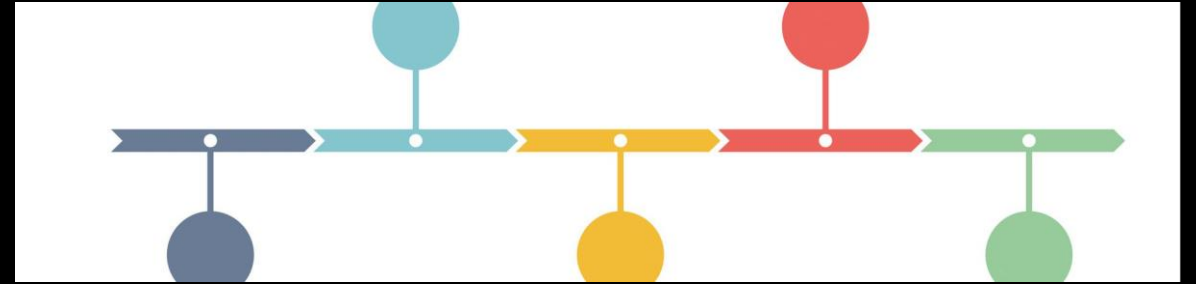
