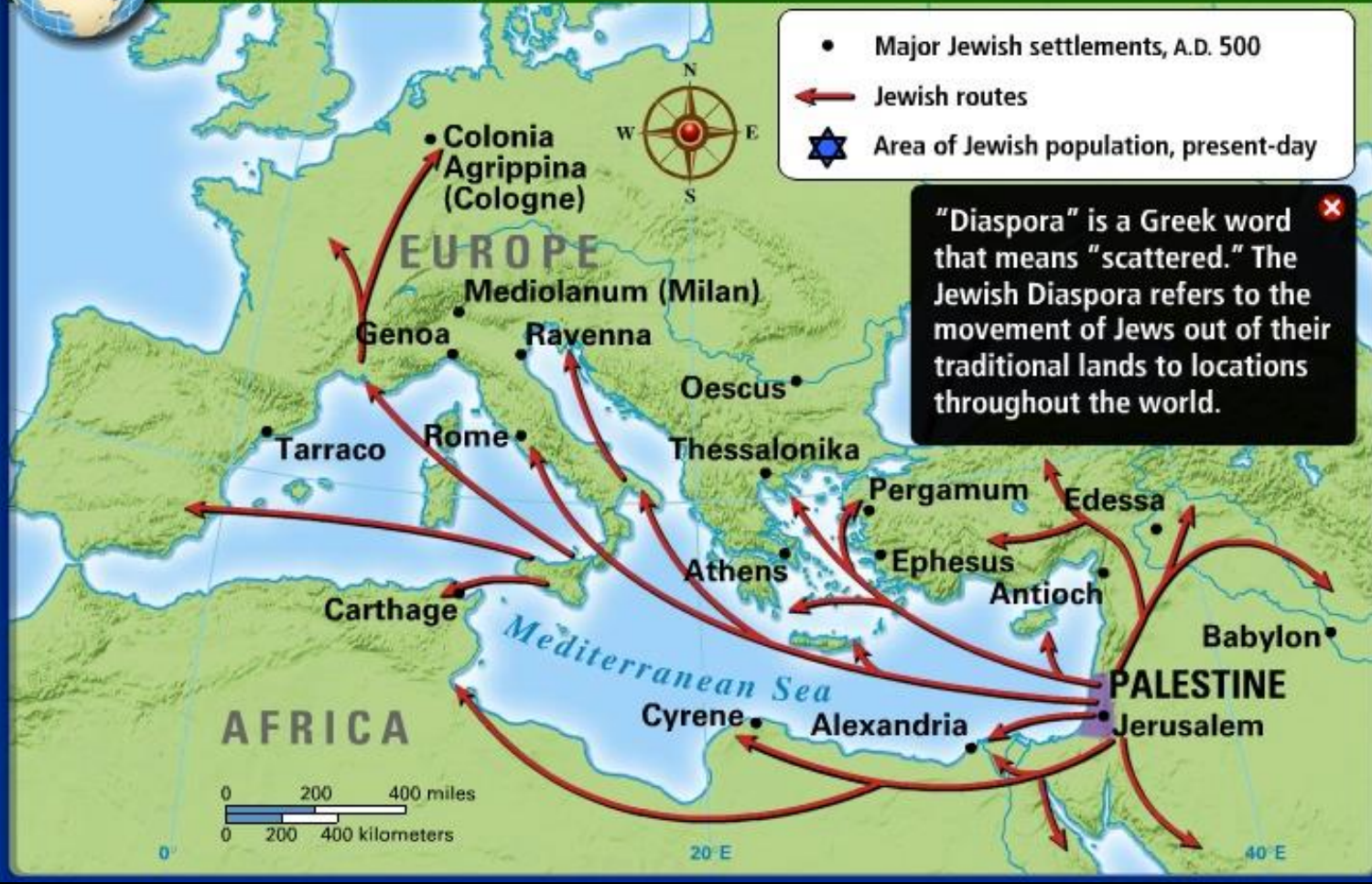


Jewish Diaspora, A.D. 70–500

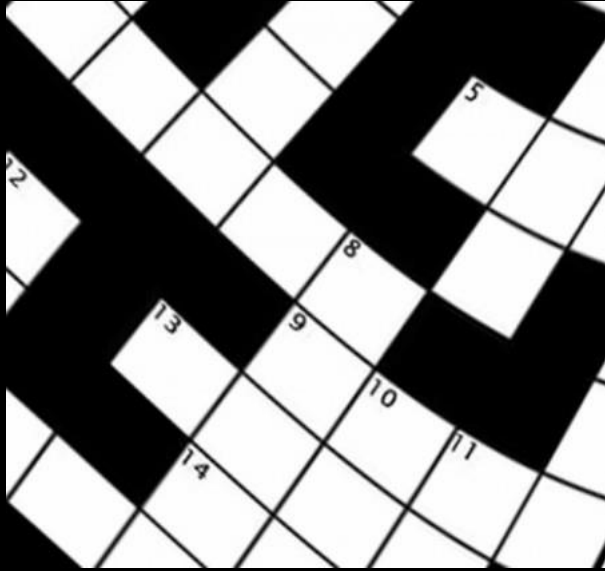
Effective flashcards have combine pictures and words to describe each vocabulary word while writing the definition on the back.

4. Answer yourself verbally and use the cards both ways.

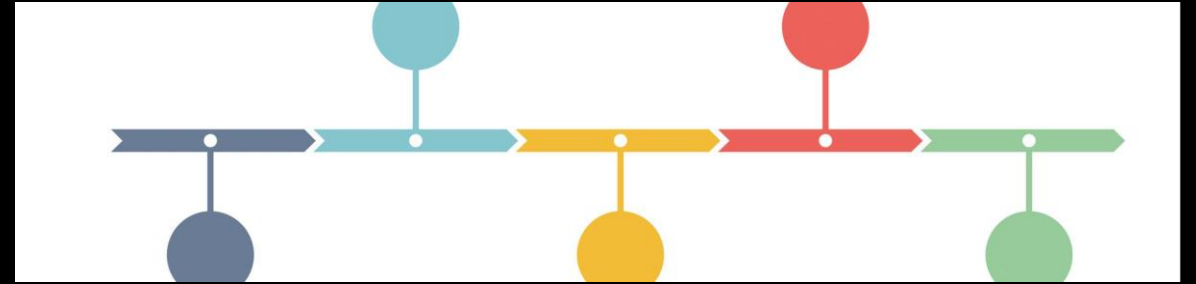
