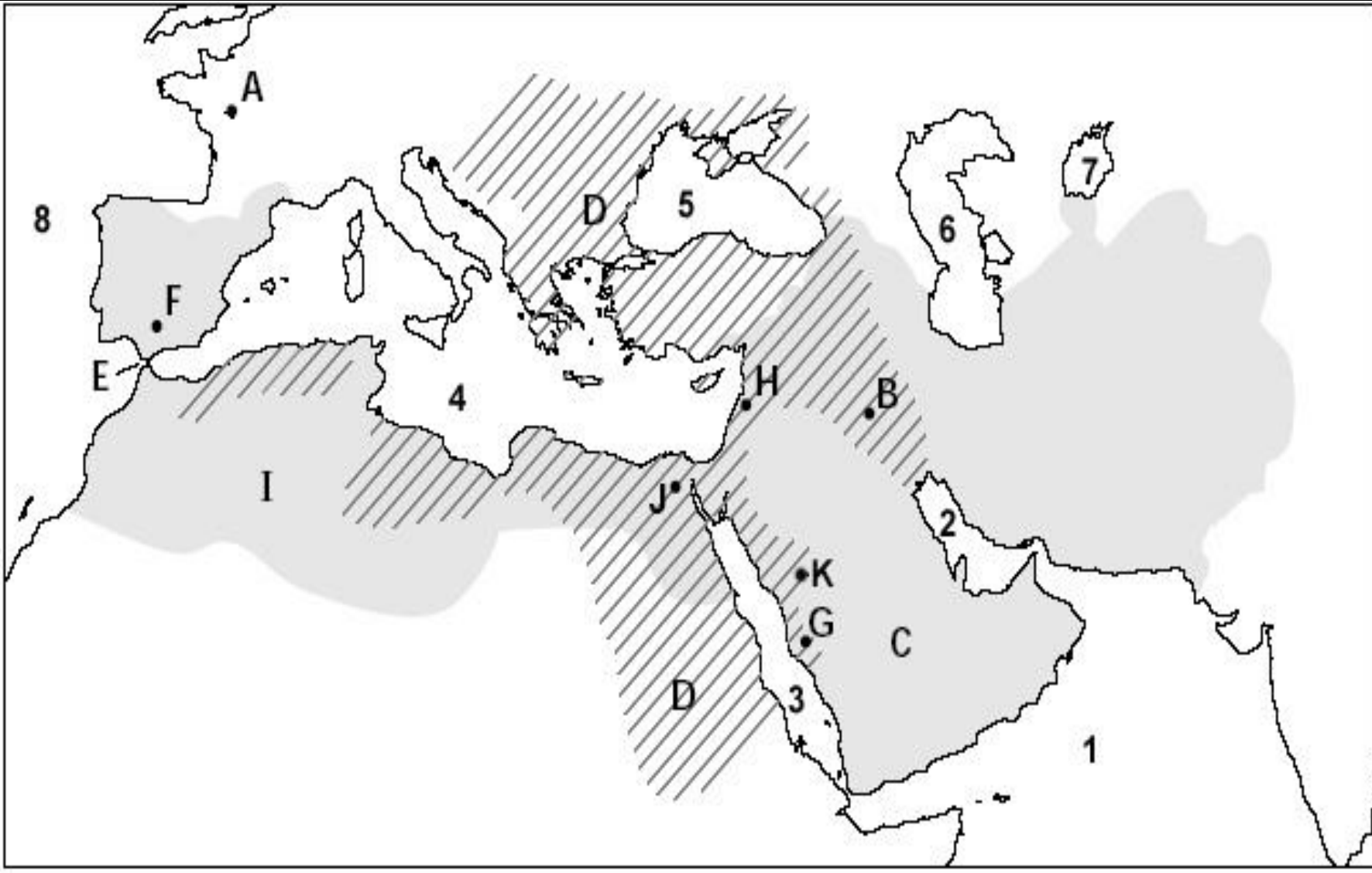

Founder: Muhammad



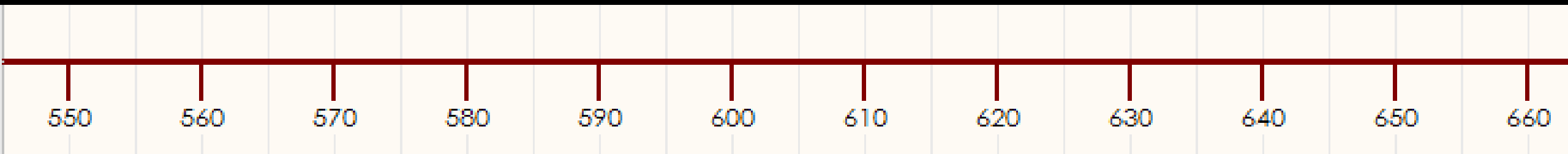
When: 7th Century or 600-700 AD

AD 570: Born in Mecca, Saudi Arabia

Married Khadijah at 25 years old

AD 610: Proclaimed the Messenger of Allah



Began to preach publicly three years later

AD 622: Moved to Medina (Hijra)

Eight years later returned to Mecca in victory

AD 632: Passed

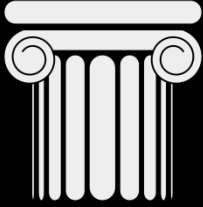

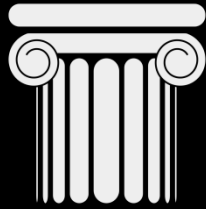

Unique Characteristics

Two main groups of Islam

Blue= Shia or Shiites

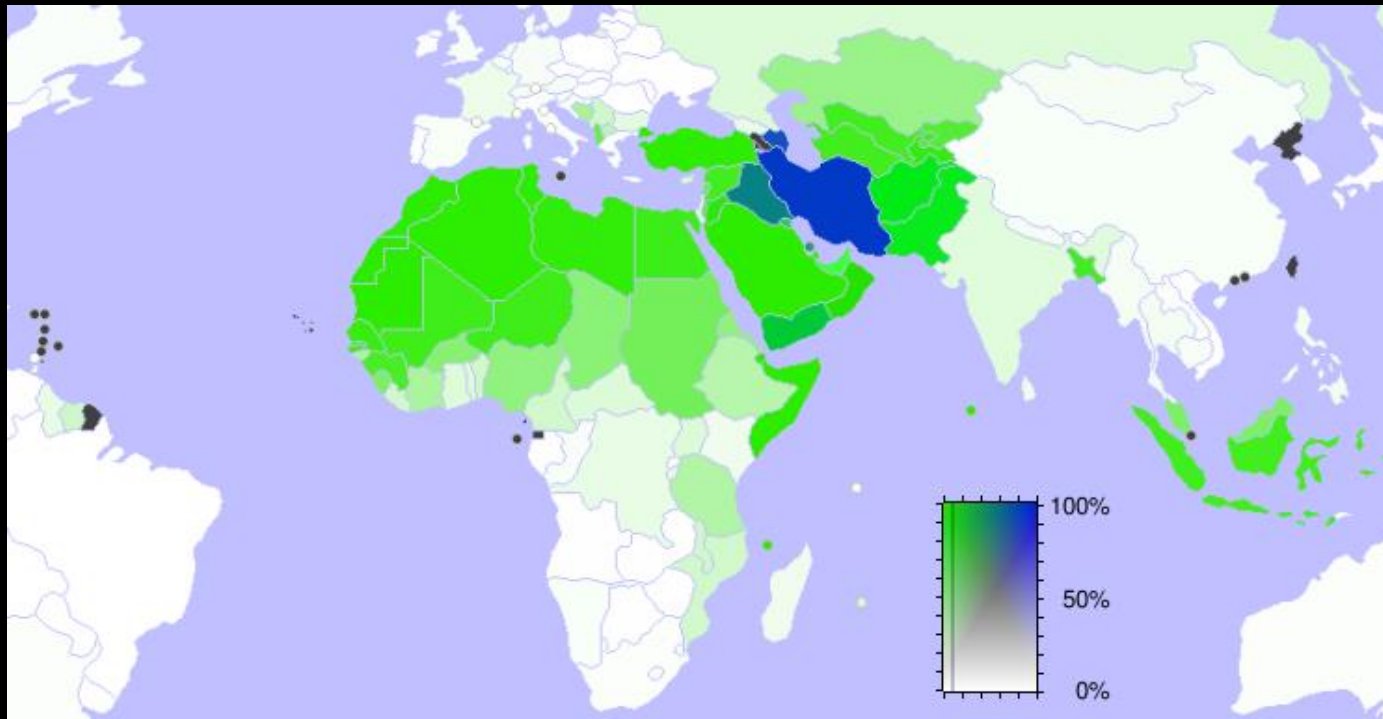
Green= Sunni

Sunni believe the leaders should be chosen

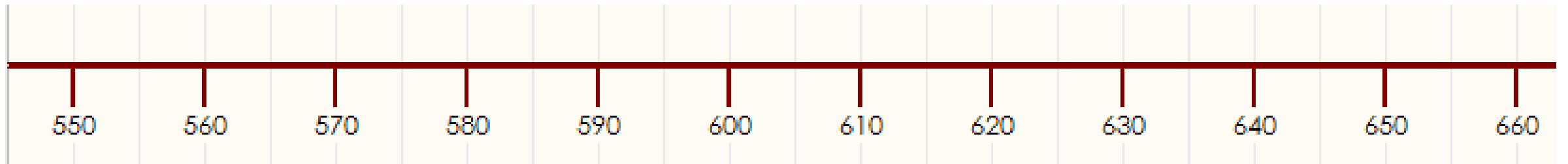
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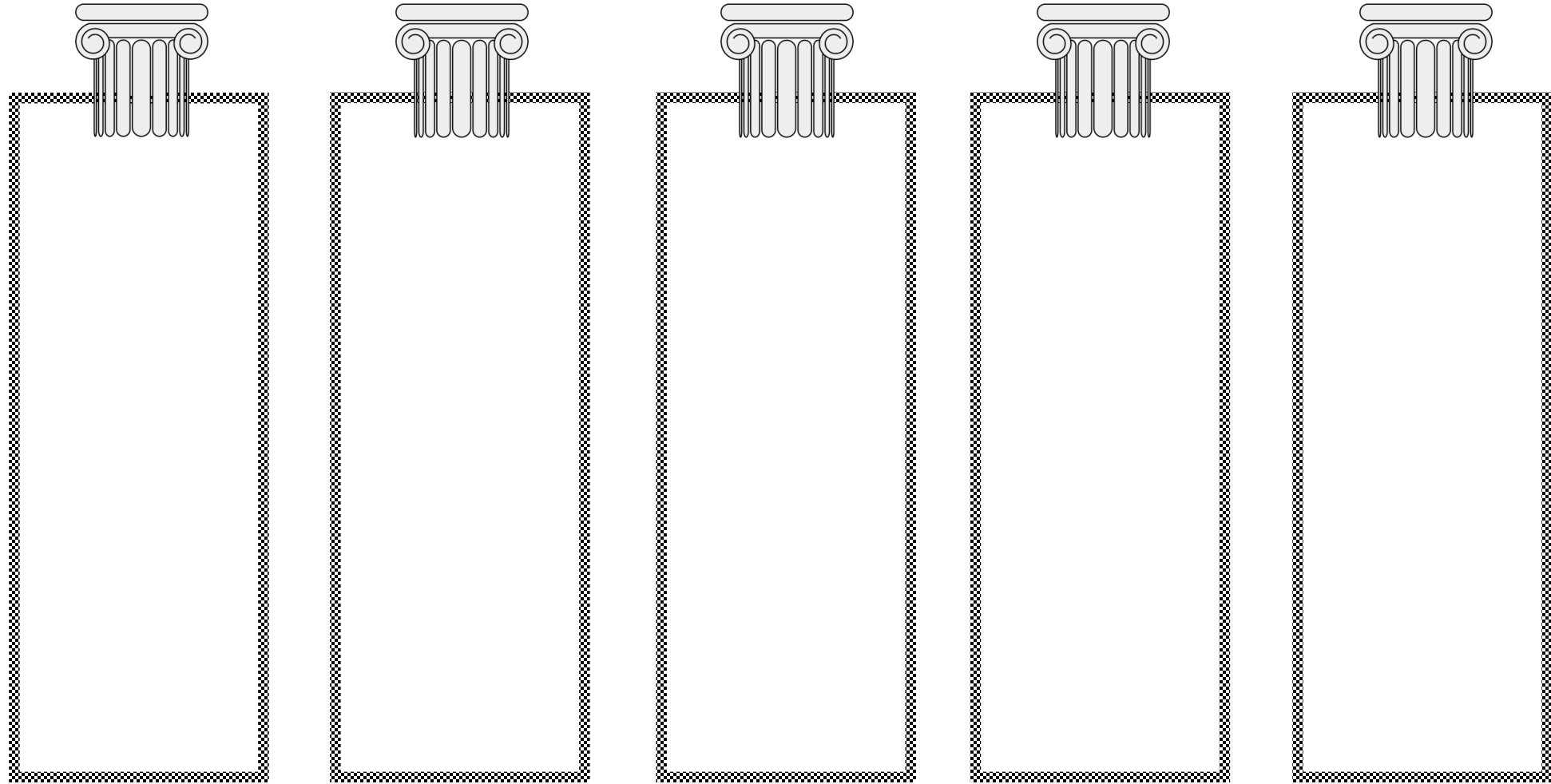

Which Pillar am I?

1. This happens five times a day and requires that you kneel facing Mecca.
2. Muslims will take this trip to the holy city of Mecca.
3. "There is no god but Allah, Muhammad is the messenger of Allah."
4. You must do this daily at sunrise, noontime, afternoon, sunset, and evening.
5. This occurs every year during the holy month of Ramadan.
6. Muslims must take this trip during a certain time and at least once in their lifetime.
7. This pillar describes the process of giving money to those less fortunate.
8. This pillar makes it clear that Muhammad is not God, but is only a prophet.
9. This is the duty of not eating from sunrise to sunset for an entire month.
10. This stops Muslims from becoming greedy and builds love between rich and poor people.

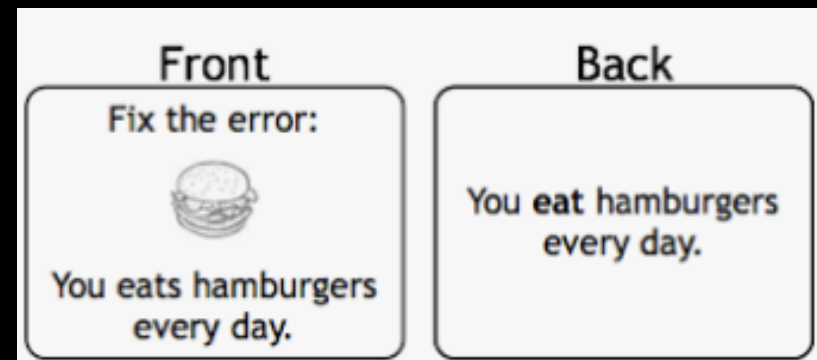
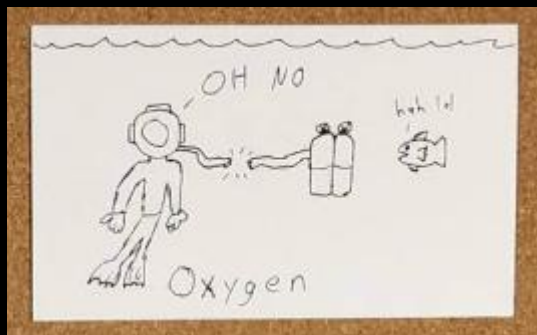

Flashcards

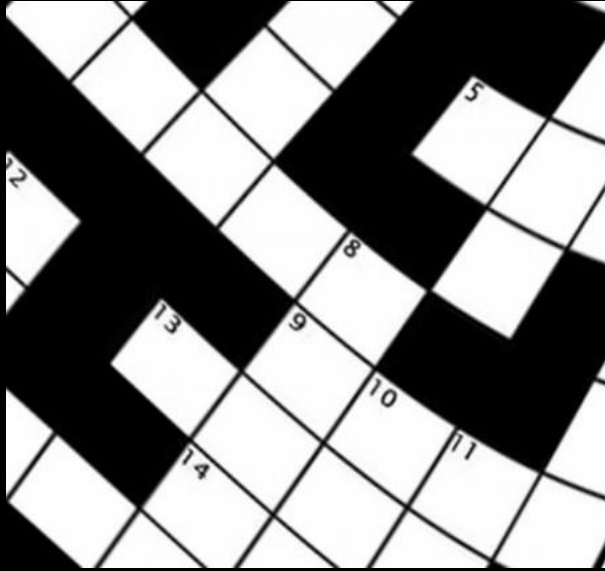
Effective flashcards have combine pictures and words to describe each vocabulary word while writing the definition on the back.

4. Answer yourself verbally and use the cards both ways.

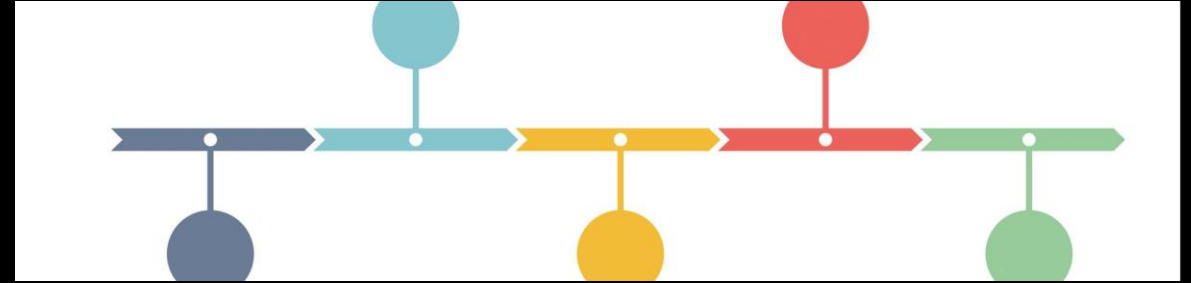
