| William the Conqueror invades England in 1066. | Hugh Capet increases the territory of France. |
| Henry II (1154–1189) introduces the use of the jury in English courts. | Philip II (1180–1223) establishes bailiffs to preside over courts and collect taxes. |
| Edward I (1272–1307) calls the Model Parliament in 1295. | Philip IV (1285–1314) adds Third Estate to the Estates-General. |

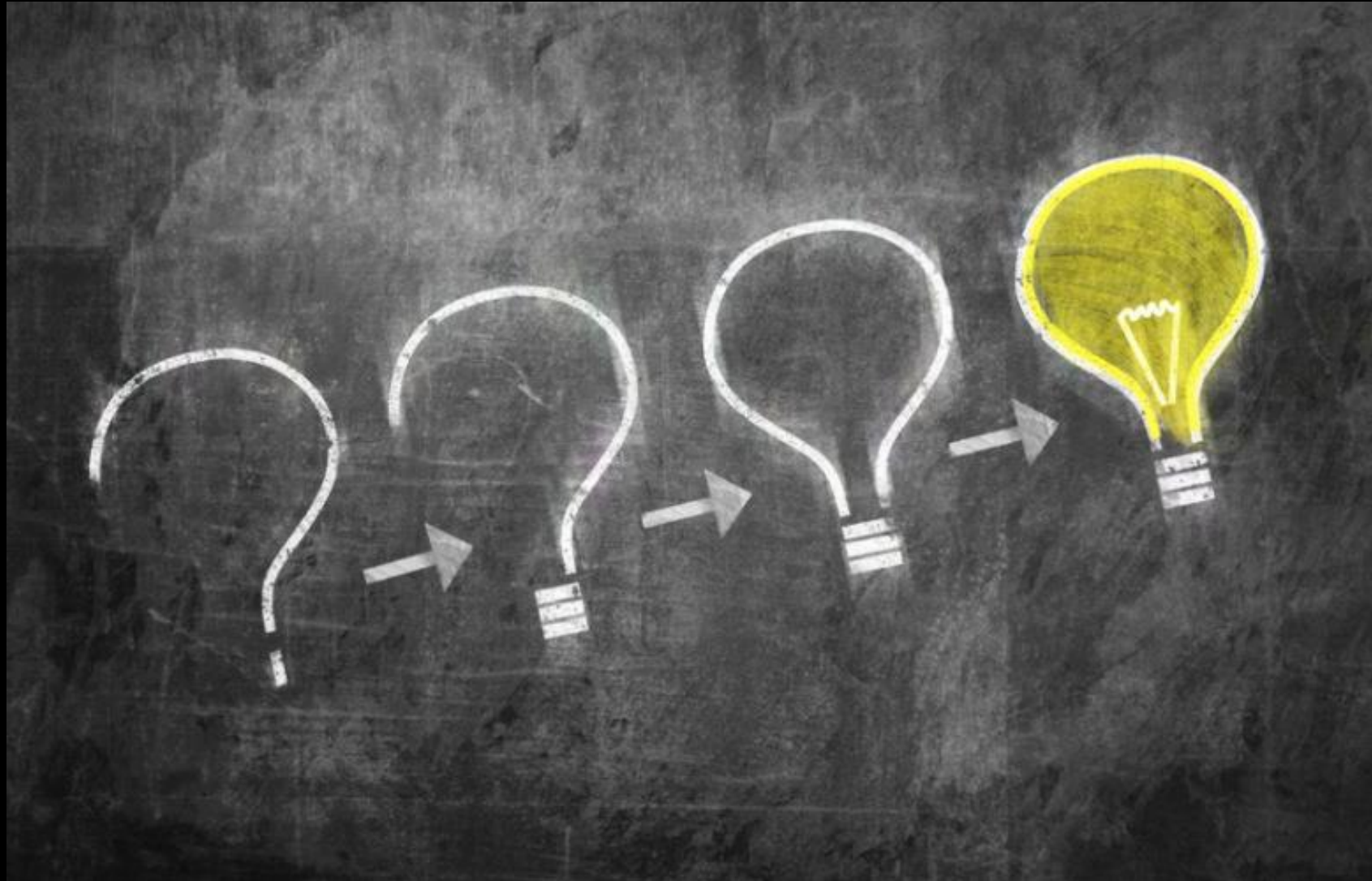

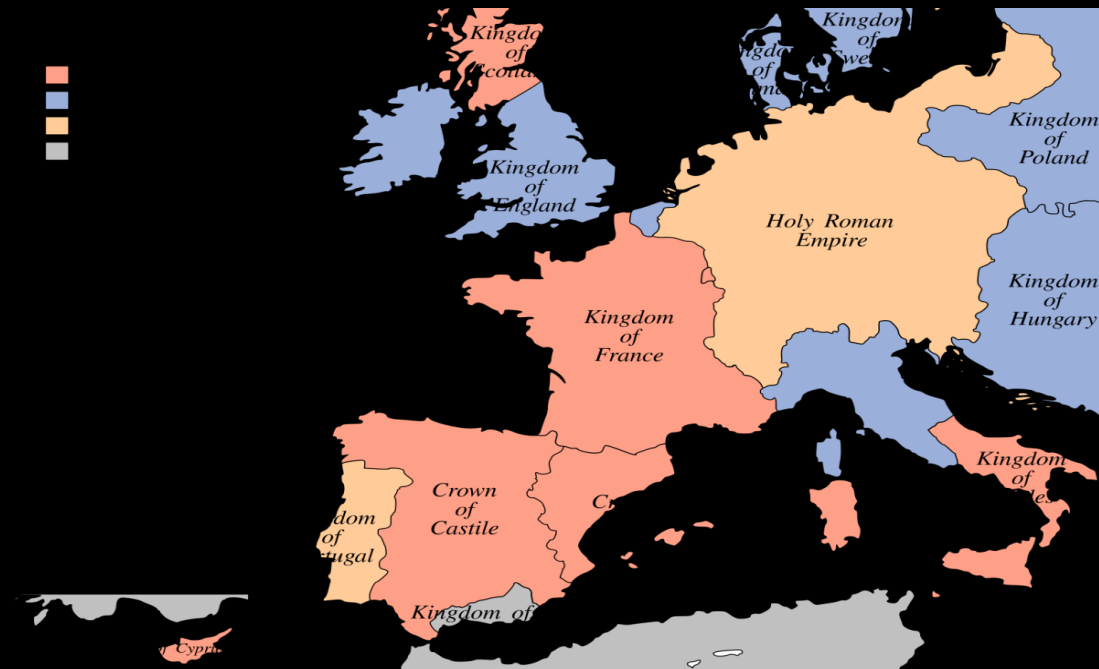

Religious Conflicts

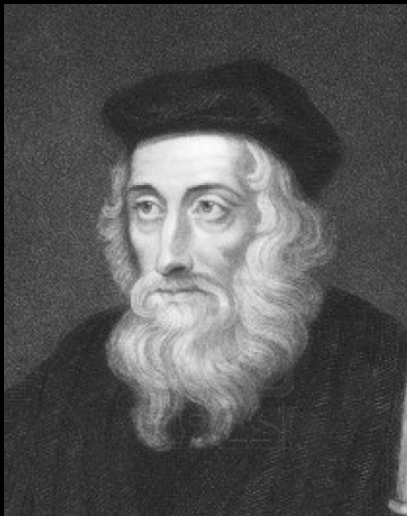
- The fight between the Pope and Philip IV led to a schism or division.
Una pelea entre un rey y un papa llevó a un cisma o división
 - From 1378 to 1417 there were three popes.
Desde 1378 hasta 1417 hubo tres papas.



Religious Conflicts

• John Wycliffe

- Preached that Jesus was head of the church
- Bible alone was the final authority
- Biblia por sí sola era la autoridad final
- Spread idea to have bible written in vernacular or common language; English



• Jan Hus

- Authority of the bible higher than the Pope
- Autoridad de la Biblia más que el Papa
- Excommunicated, tried as a heretic or non-believer, burned at the stake

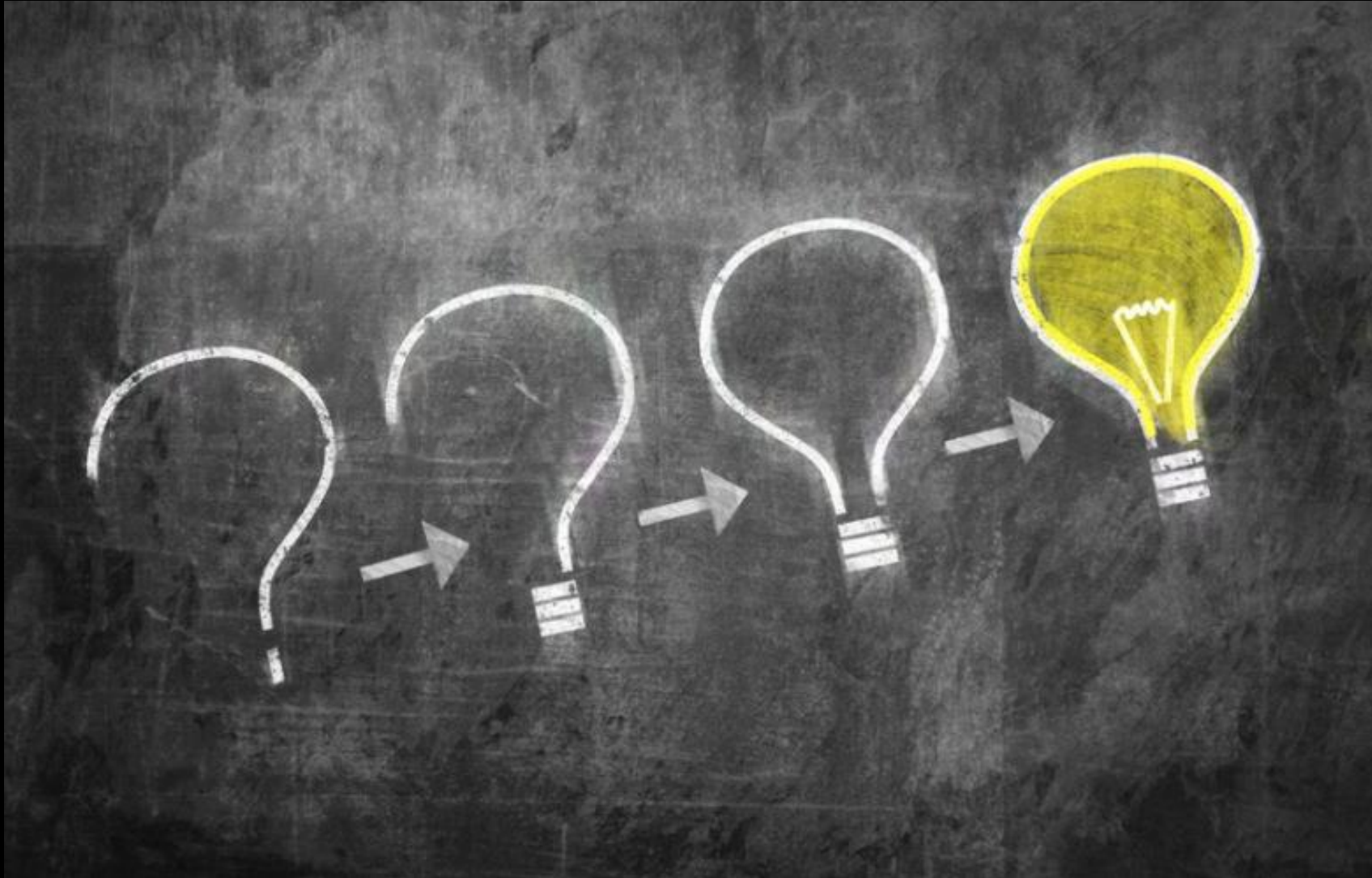

Hundred Years War

- Between France and England in 1337 to 1453
Entre Francia e Inglaterra en 1337 a 1453
- Cause: Fought over Land / Causa: Luchó por la tierra
- Outcome: English driven out of France
 - Resultado: Inglés expulsado de Francia
- How: The longbow used made the knight ineffective
 - Cómo: El Arco largo utilizado hace ineficaz el caballero
- Joan of Arc
 - 13 year old heard voices and lead the French Army to victory in Orleans
 - Captured, tried as a heretic, and burned at the stake.
- Impact
 - Nationalism emerged
 - End of the Middle Ages, Age of Faith, and Chivalry

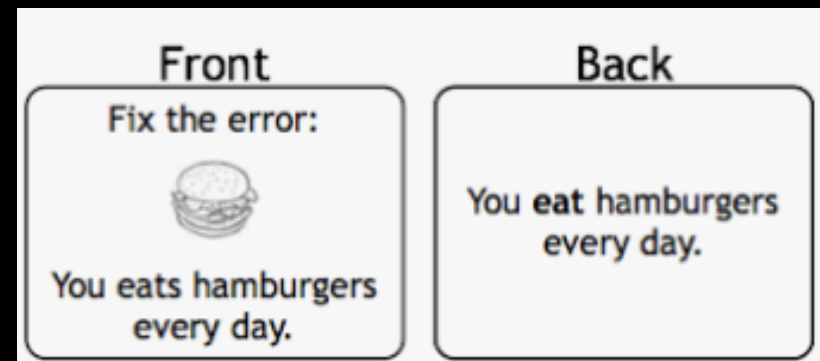


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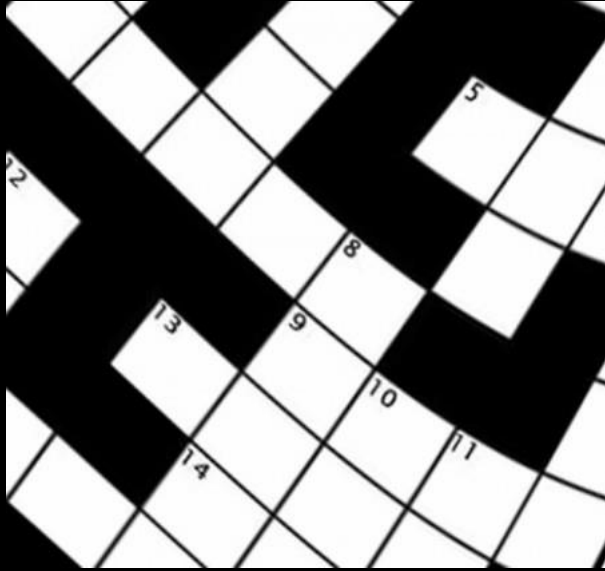


Effective flashcards have combine pictures and words to describe each vocabulary word while writing the definition on the back.

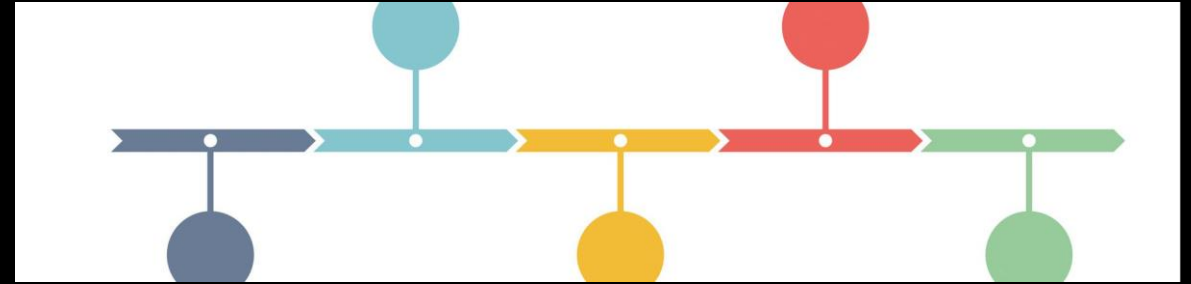
1. Draw your view of the vocabulary word on one side
