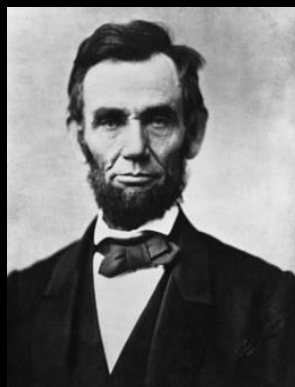
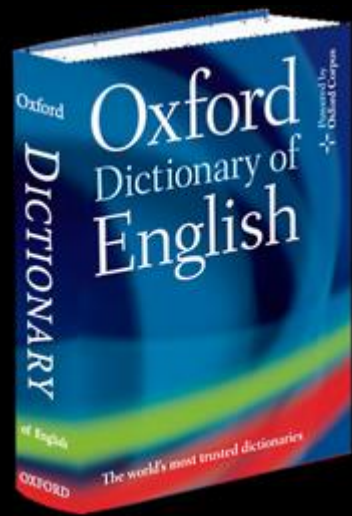
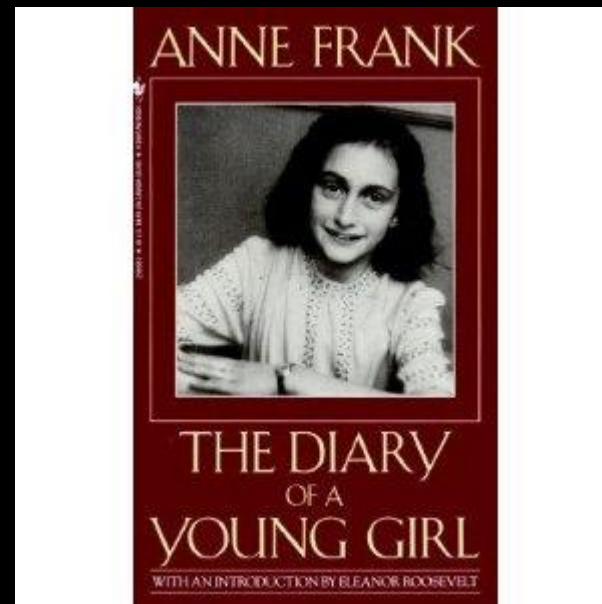
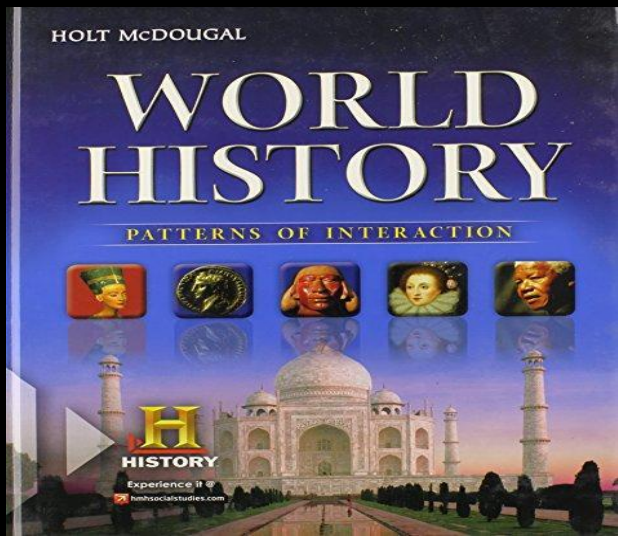


# Pulse Check

Hands up=Credible

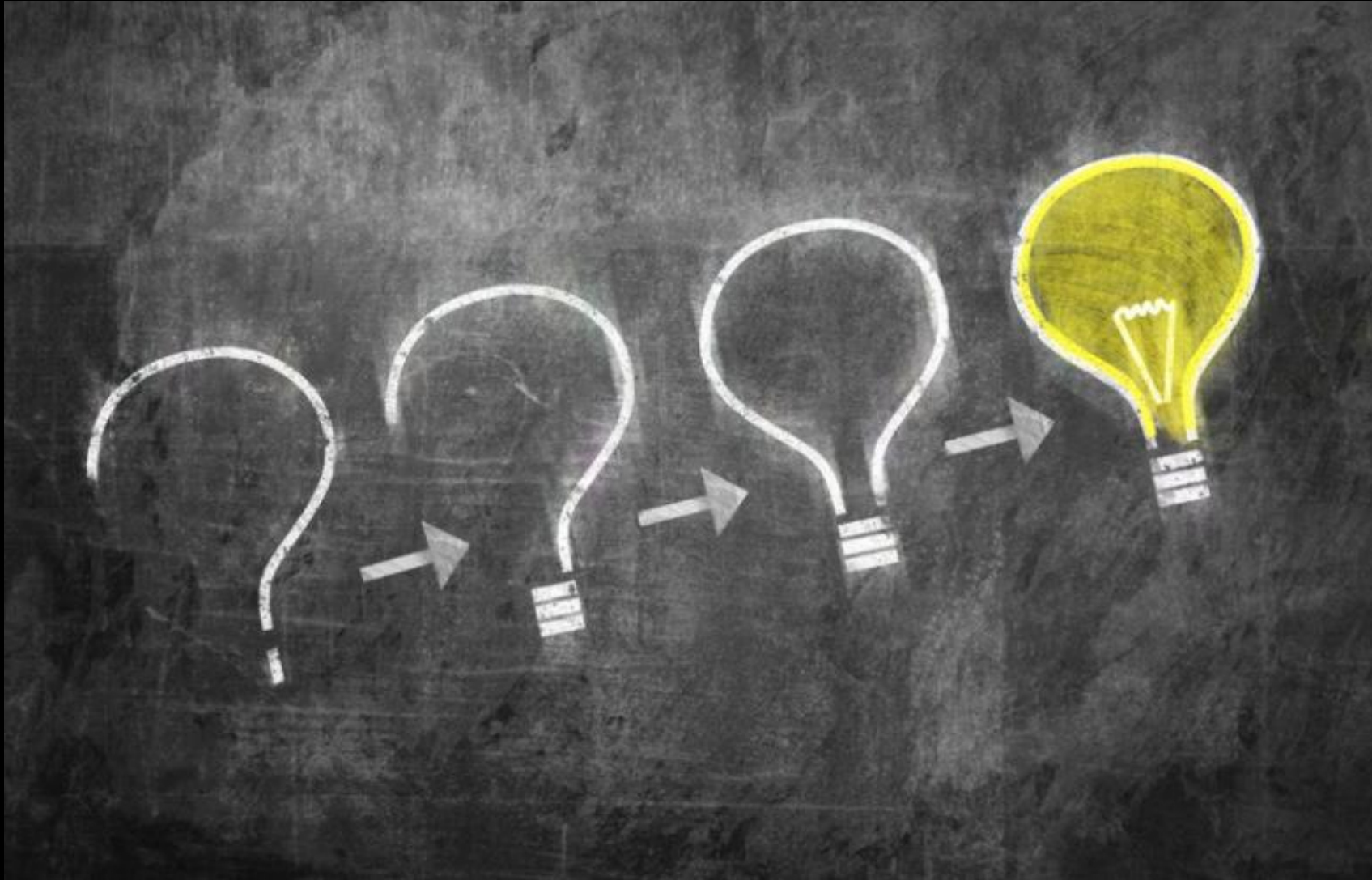
