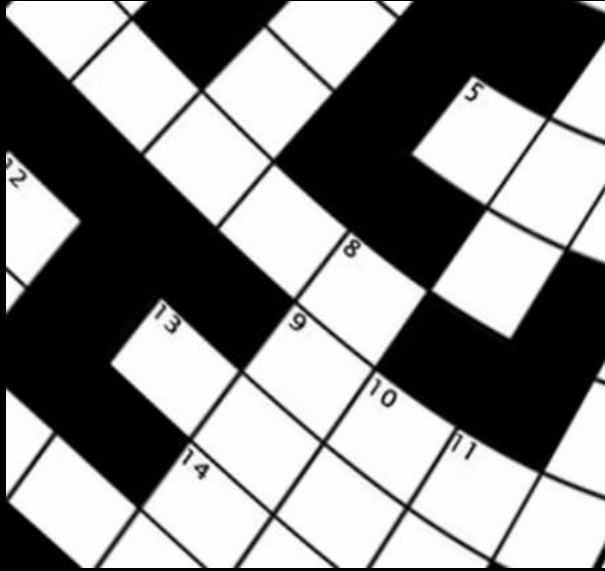
Electronic Submission Rules

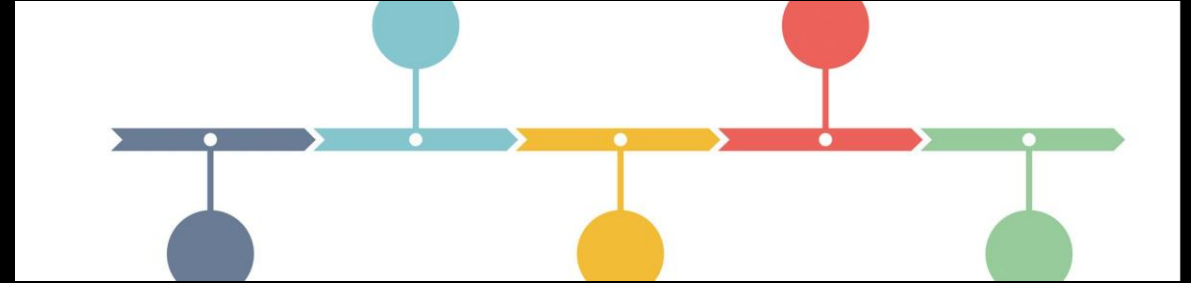
