Thesis Statement

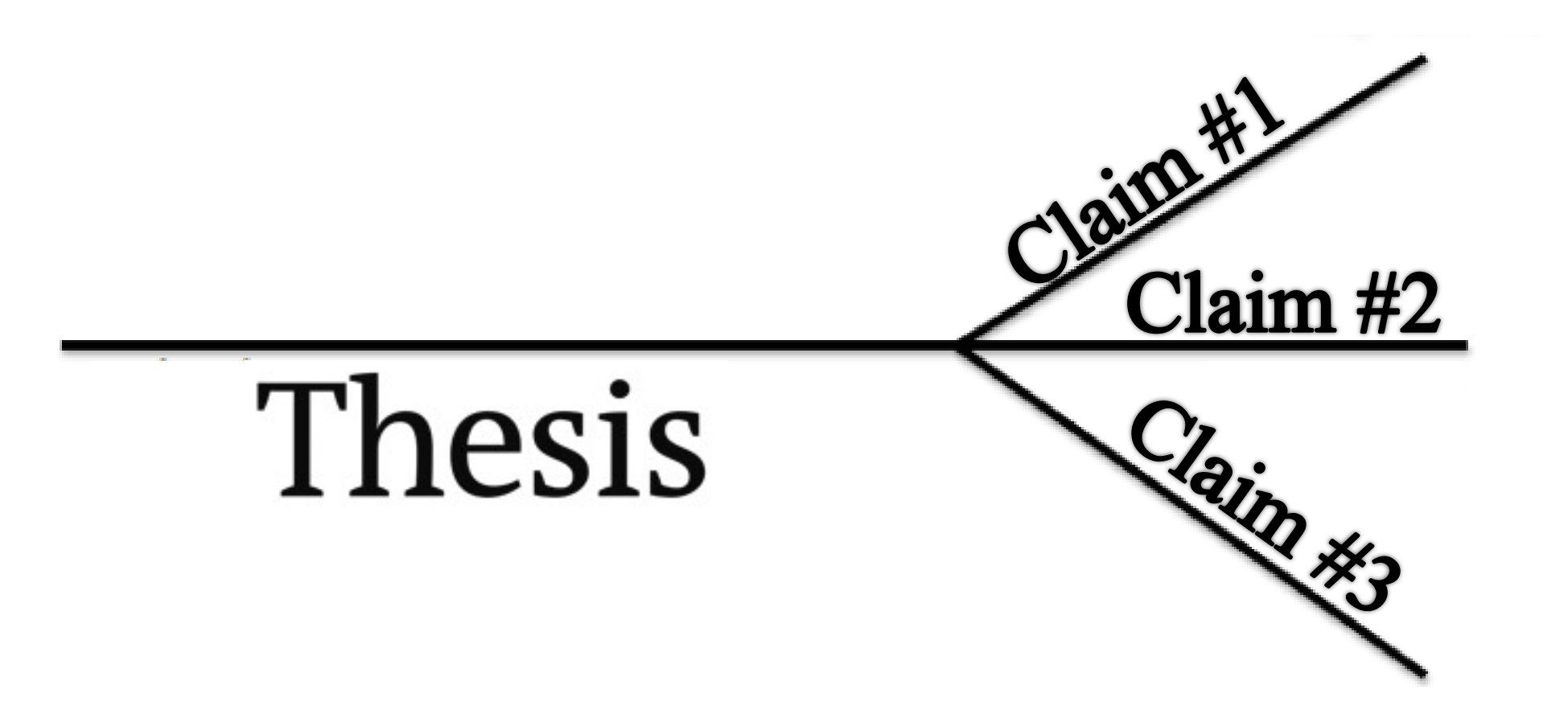
- Why are we learning this?

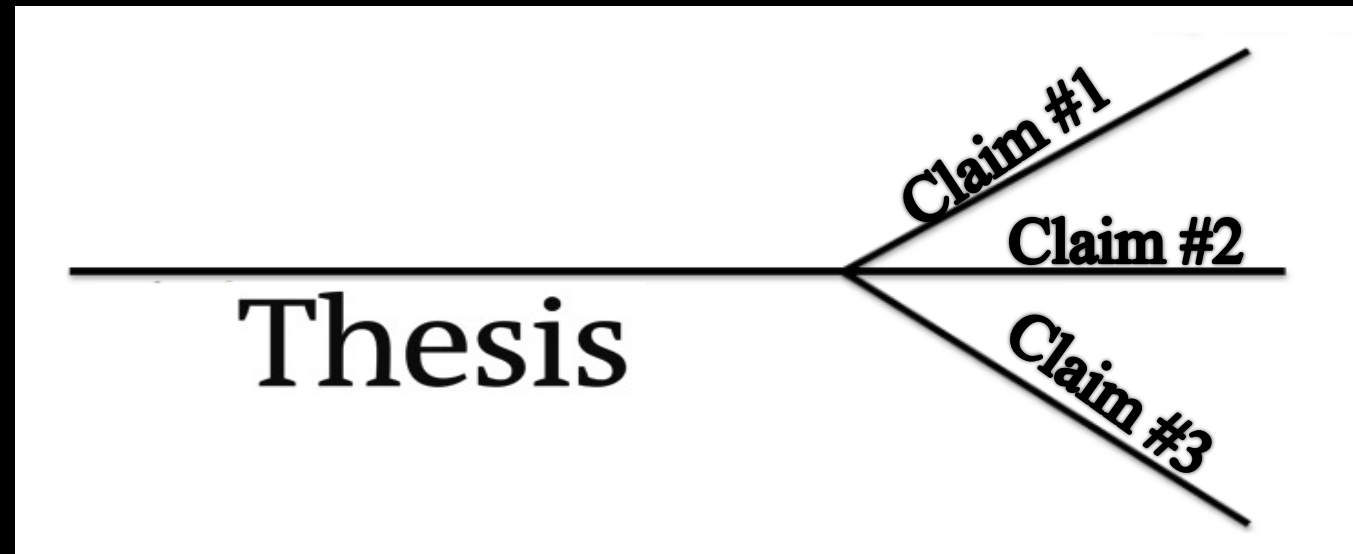

Thesis + **THREE [3]** Claims = Thesis Statement

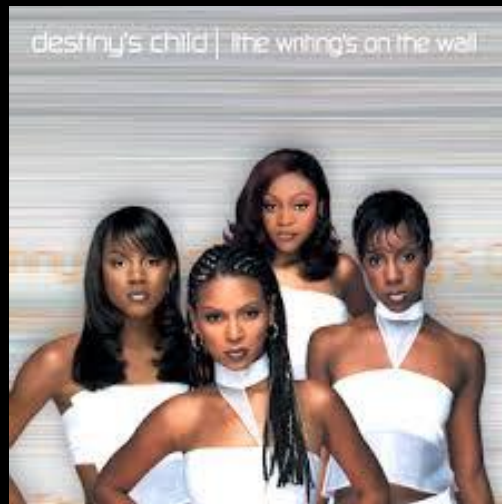
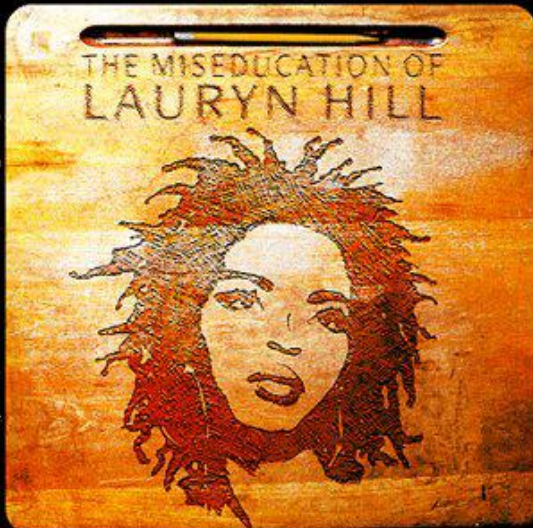
Thesis Statement is the one sentence statement that tells the reader your position and why you are taking that stance.



Thesis Statement Example

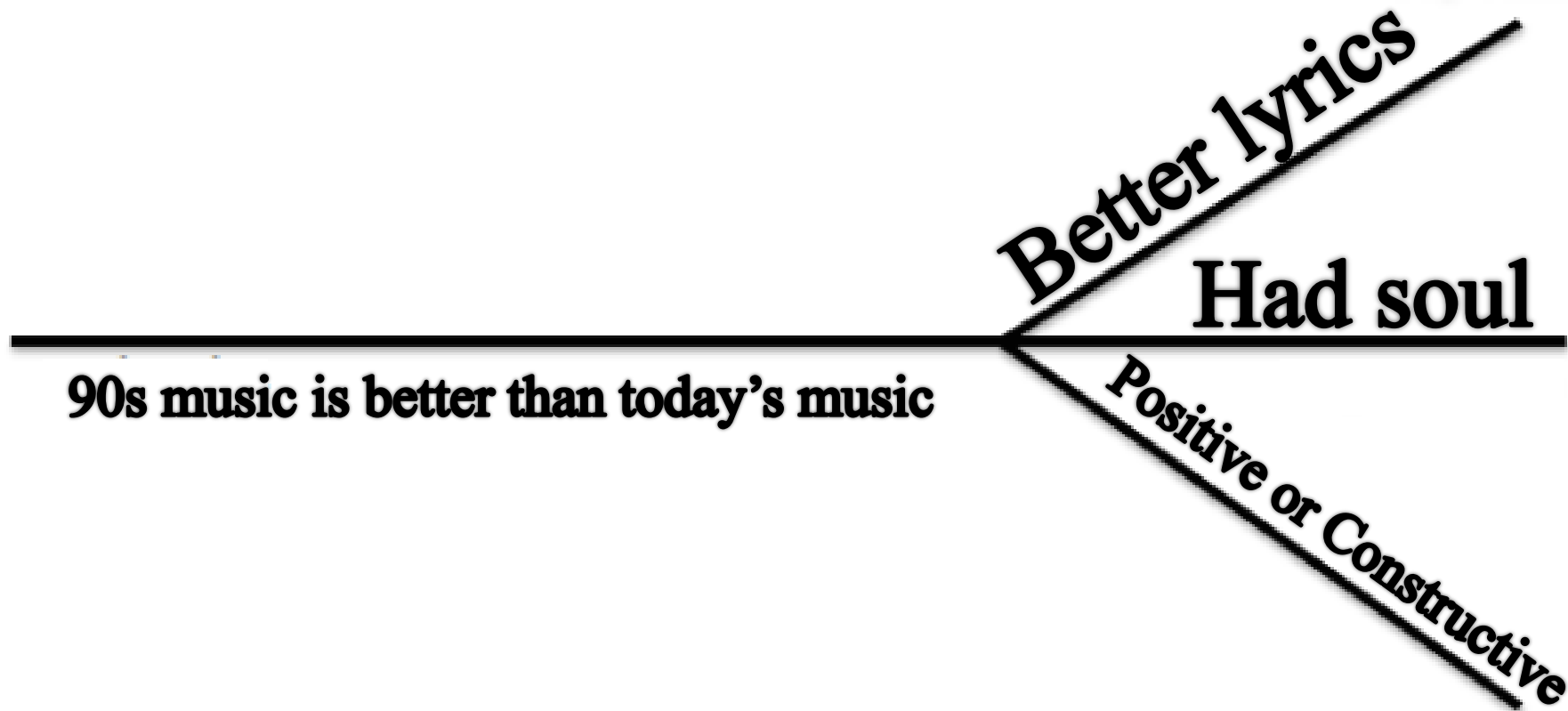
Question: Is 90s music better than today's music?

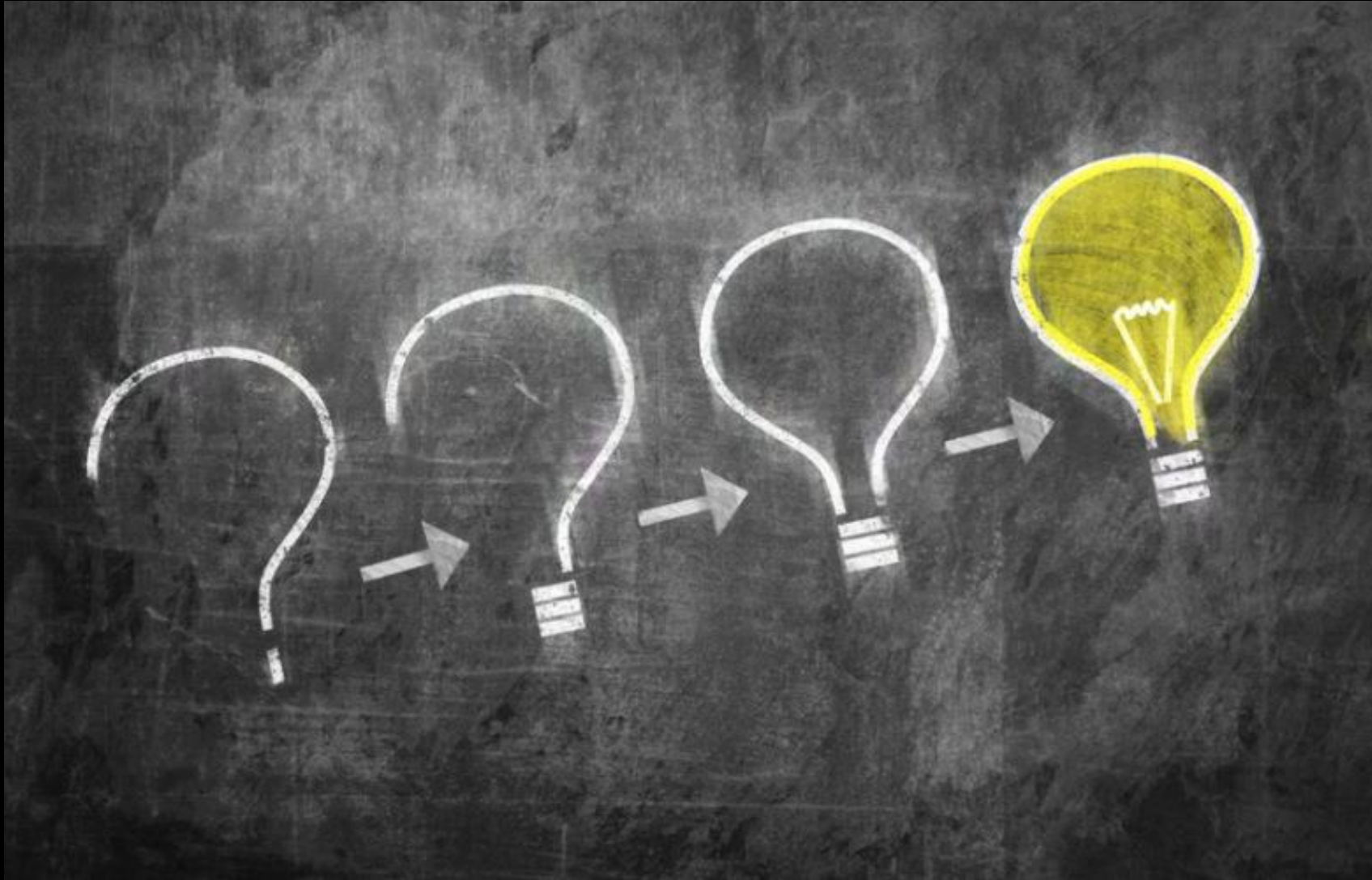

90s music is better than today's music because the lyrics were better, the music had soul, and the topics were more positive or constructive.

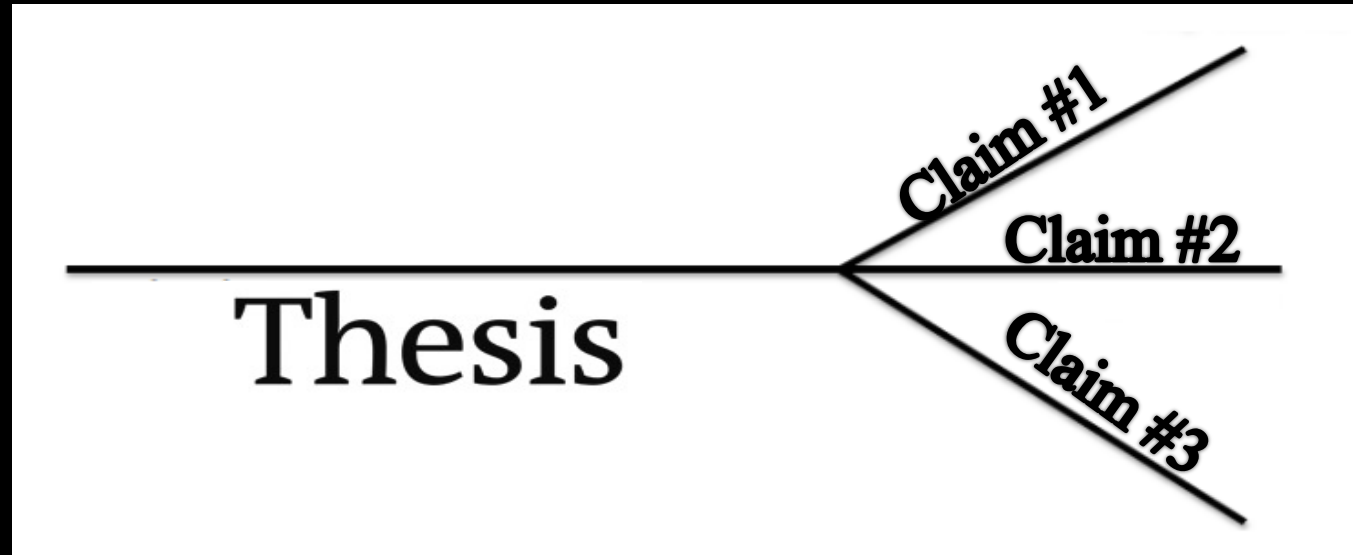

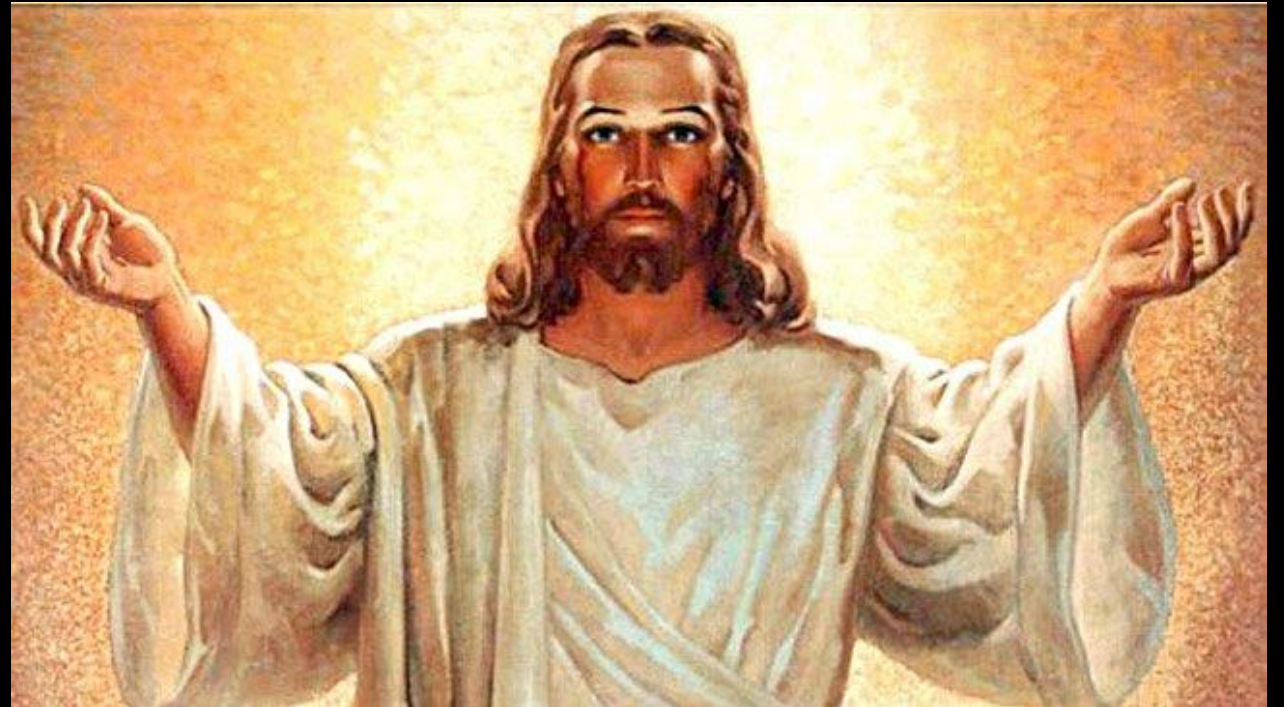
Christians= Catholics, Baptists, Mormons, Jehovah Witness...

Christians believe in an all-powerful and omnipotent **God** thus they are **monotheistic**.

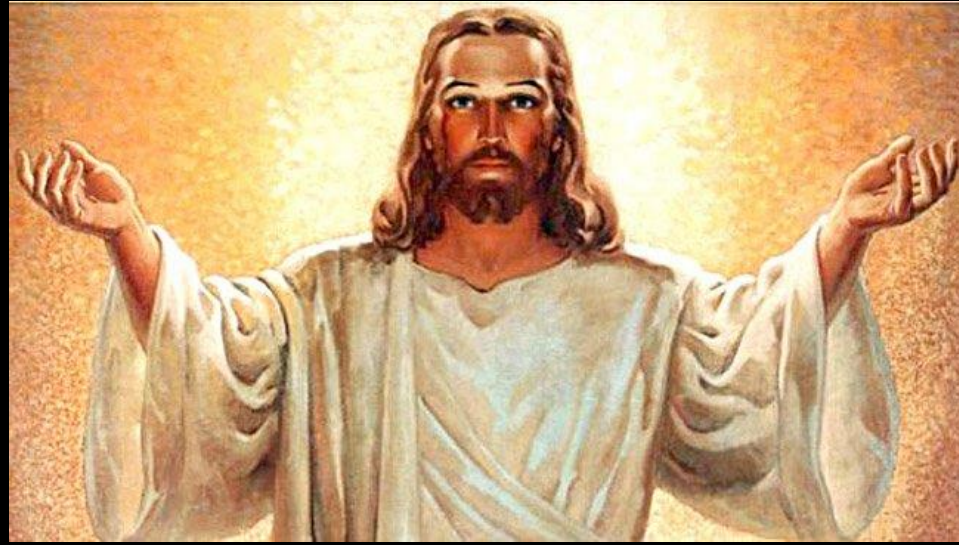

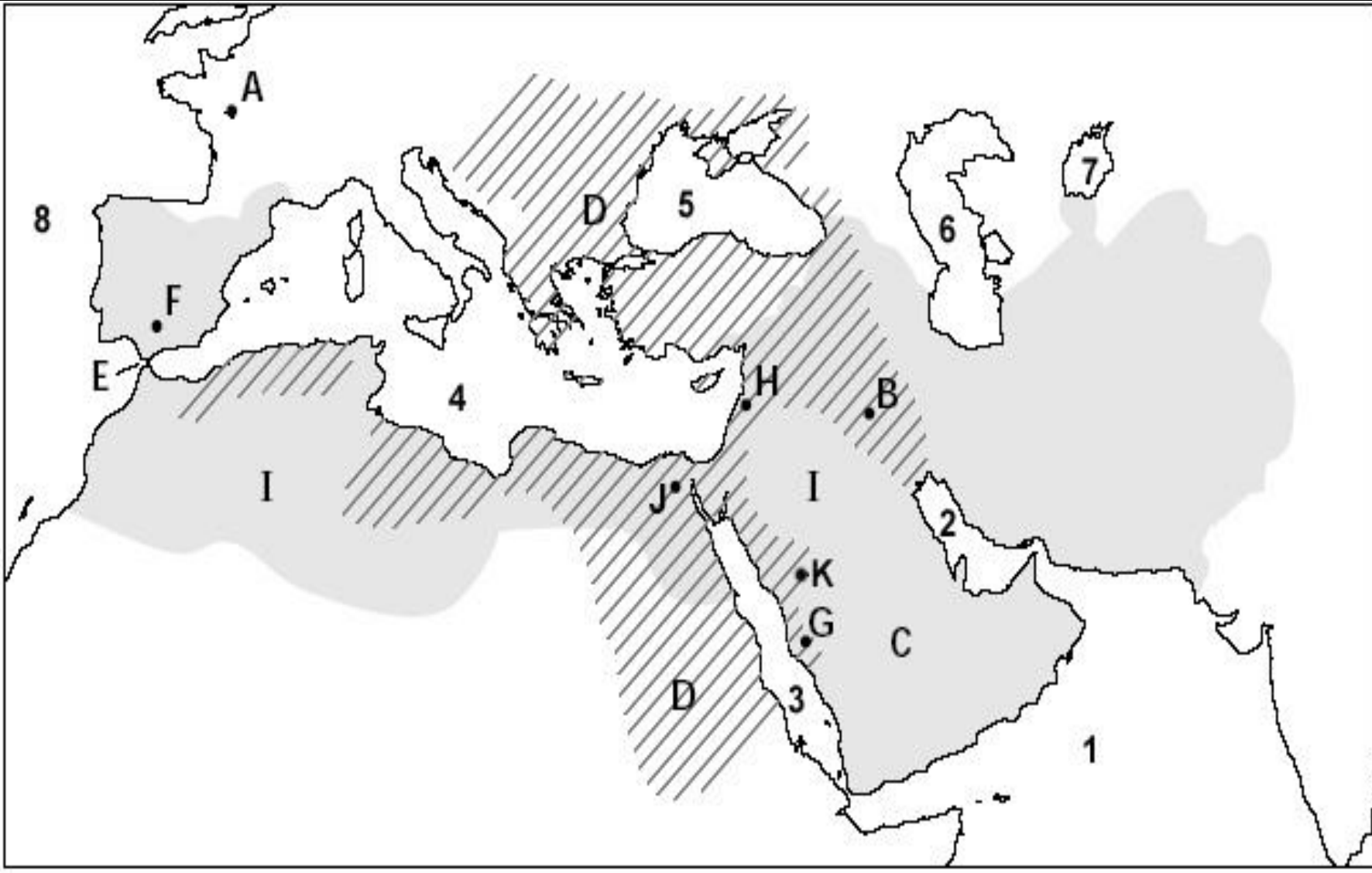

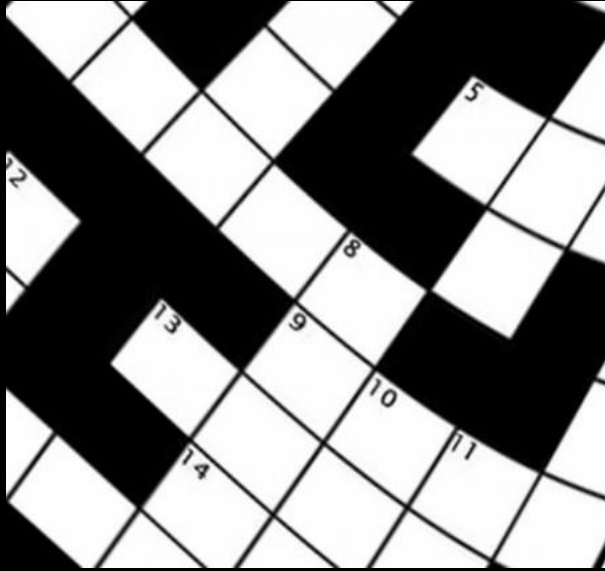
Electronic Submission Rules

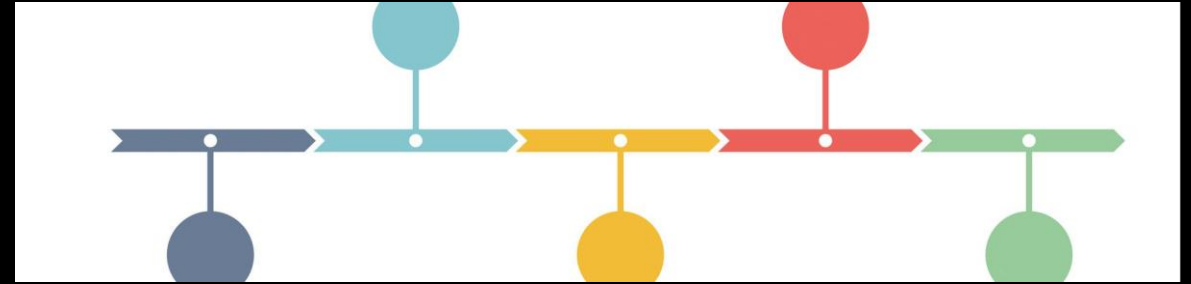
